AN ACT CONVERTING THE SALIOK NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY SALIOK, MUNICIPALITY OF NATONIN, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE INTO A NATIONAL TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS SALIOK NATIONAL TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL AND SKILLS TRAINING HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Saliok National High School in Barangay Saliok,
2 Municipality of Natonin, Mountain Province is hereby converted into a
3 national technical-vocational high school to be known as Saliok National
4 Technical-Vocational and Skills Training High School.
- 5 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Saliok
6 National High School are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Saliok
7 National Technical-Vocational and Skills Training High School.
- 8 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the
9 Department's program the operationalization of the Saliok National

1 Technical-Vocational and Skills Training High School, the initial funding of
2 which shall be charged against the current year's appropriation of the Saliok
3 National High School. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued
4 operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations
5 Act.

6 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall issue rules and regulations
7 necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

8 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
9 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
