### AN ACT

IMPROVING PUBLIC AWARENESS REGARDING SAFE USE OF THE INTERNET THROUGH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN OFFICE OF INTERNET SAFETY AND PUBLIC AWARENESS WITHIN THE NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The Constitution, Article 2, Section 24 provides:

Section 24. The State recognizes the vital role of communication and information in nation-building.

As we move further into the Information Age, more and more people are logging in to the information superhighway, more commonly known as the Internet. In a survey taken by Synovate<sup>1</sup> on urban areas across the Philippines,<sup>2</sup> it was shown that about 36% of Filipinos from these areas have Internet access while 41 % have mobile phones with Internet access.

As Internet usage increases, the perils likewise increase. Viruses, scam sites and sites with undesirable contents proliferate on a daily basis. To protect our people, our government must do what it can to aim our Internet users with useful information to combat the dangers that are spread across the world wide web.

This bill seeks to establish an office that will spearhead the information campaign that will keep our Internet users abreast with the latest online technologies and arm them with the knowledge against the perils of the Internet.<sup>3</sup>

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Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. Short Title. This Act shall be known as the "Safeguarding
- 2 Filipinos by Enhancing and Reorganizing New and Efficient Technologies Act" or the
- 3 "SAFER NET Act."
- 4 SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy. The Constitution, Article 2, Section 24
- 5 states that the State recognizes the vital role of communication and information in nation-
- 6 building. The State shall promote the safe and effective ways of using the internet as we
- 7 head further into the information age.
- 8 SECTION 3. Definition of Terms. For purposes of this Act, the term:
- 9 (A) "Commission" means the National Telecommunications Commission;
- 10 (B) "Internet" means collectively the myriad of computer and telecommunications
- 11 facilities, including equipment and operating software, which comprise the
- 12 interconnected world-wide network of networks that employ the Transmission Control
- 13 Protocol/Internet Protocol, or any predecessor or successor protocols to such protocol, to
- 14 communicate information of all kinds by wire or radio; and

- 1 (C) "Office" means the Office of Internet Safety and Public Awareness of the 2 National Telecommunications Commission, established by Section 4.
- 3 SECTION 4. Establishment of the Office. The National Telecommunications
- 4 Commission shall establish an Office of Internet Safety and Public Awareness, which
- 5 shall have responsibility for programs and activities relating to increasing public
- 6 awareness and providing education regarding Internet safety.
- SECTION 5. *Director*. The Office shall be headed by a Director who shall be appointed by the Commission.
  - SECTION 6. Internet Safety. For purposes of this Act, the issue of Internet safety includes issues regarding use of the Internet in a manner that promotes safe online activity, including safe transactions involved in online commerce, and protects against threats to financial information and privacy, threats from cyber-crime, and threats to juveniles, including cyber predators and material that is inappropriate for minors.

### 14 SECTION 7. Duties. –

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- (A) Activities The Commission, acting through the Office, shall carry out a nationwide program to increase public awareness and education regarding Internet safety, for families, businesses, organizations, and other users, that utilizes existing resources and efforts of the national and local governments, nonprofit organizations, private technology and financial companies, Internet service providers, World Wide Web-based resources, and other appropriate entities, that includes –
- 21 (1) evaluating Internet safety efforts and activities provided at various levels of 22 government and by other entities;
  - (2) improving efficiency of Internet safety efforts and activities, by eliminating redundancy of efforts at various levels of government and other entities, identifying,

- promoting, and expanding effective such efforts and activities and coordinating among such efforts and activities;
- 3 (3) identifying, promoting, and encouraging best practices for Internet safety;
- 4 (4) establishing and carrying out a national outreach and education campaign 5 regarding Internet safety utilizing various media and Internet-based resources;
  - (5) serving as the primary contact in the national government, and as a national clearing house, for information and public awareness efforts regarding Internet safety;
  - (6) facilitating access to, and the exchange of, information regarding Internet safety to promote up-to-date knowledge regarding current issues;
  - (7) providing expert advice and consultation to the Commission regarding Internet safety issues; and
    - (8) providing assistance, including technical assistance and financial assistance under paragraph (B), units of local government, schools, police departments, nonprofit organizations, and such other entities as the Office considers appropriate to promote Internet safety education and public awareness.

### (B) Grants and Contracts –

- (1) In carrying out this subsection, the Commission, acting through the Office, may make grants, to the extent amounts are provided in advance in appropriation acts for such grants, and enter into cooperative agreements, contracts, and interagency agreements with units of local government, schools, police departments, non-profit organizations, and such other public and private agencies, entities, and organizations as the Office considers appropriate.
- (2) The Commission, acting through the Office, shall provide for evaluations of projects and activities carried out with financial assistance provided under paragraph (B)(1) and for the dissemination of information developed as a result of such projects.

- SECTION 8. Annual Reports. The Commission, acting through the Office, shall
- 2 submit a report not later than March 31 of each year that -
- 3 (A) describes the activities of the Office during the preceding calendar year;
- 4 (B) contains any evaluations performed pursuant to Section (7)(B)(2) for any
- 5 projects and activities carried out during the preceding calendar with assistance under
- 6 Section (7)(B)(l);
- 7 (C) describes and analyzes the, current state, as of the preparation of such report,
- 8 of Internet safety, existing and emerging threats to Internet safety, and costs to the
- 9 Philippine economy resulting from preventing, responding to, eliminating, and otherwise
- dealing with threats to Internet safety.
- 11 SECTION 9. Appropriations. To carry out the provisions of this Act, such
- amount as hereby necessary is hereby authorized to be appropriated from the National
- 13 Treasury.
- SECTION 10. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Act is held invalid or
- unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other
- 16 provisions hereof.
- 17 SECTION 11. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, orders, and issuances, or
- 18 portions thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, are hereby
- 19 repealed, amended or modified accordingly.
- SECTION 12. Effectivity Clause. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
- 21 after its publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) newspapers of general
- 22 circulation.
