MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government and Electoral Reforms and Peoples' Participation to which was referred House Bill No. 4776, introduced by Representative Elpidio F. Barzaga, Jr., entitled:

"AN ACT

CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY NEW ERA IN THE CITY OF DASMARINAS, PROVINCE OF CAVITE"

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, line 4, before Section 2 (Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite), insert a new section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES.- THE TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION OF BARANGAY NEW ERA SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

BOUNDED ON THE SW., ALONG LINE 1-4, BY AGUINALDO HIGHWAY; ON THE NW., ALONG LINES 4-5, BY LOT 7384-F, (LRC) PSD-348926 AND BARANGAY OF SAMPALOC-II; ON THE SW., ALONG LINES 5-12, BY CREEK AND BEYOND BY BARANGAY OF SAMPALOC-II; ON THE NW., ALONG LINES 12-17, BY BLK. 22, STATELAND INVSETMENT CORPORATION AND BARANGAY OF SAMPALOC-II; ON THE NE., ALONG LINES 17-31, BY STO. NIÑO CREEK AND BEYOND BY BARANGAY SAMPALOC-II; ON THE SE., ALONG LINES 31-32, BY LOT 3877 AND BY BARANGAY SAMPALOC-II; ON THE SW., ALONG LINES 32-43, BY CREEK AND BEYOND BY SAMPALOC II; ON THE SE., ALONG LINES 43-1, BY LOT 7384-C (LRC) PSD-321118 AND BY BARANGAY SAMPALOC-II.

BY REPRESENTATIVE BARZAGA, PER COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 363

AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
NEW ERA IN THE CITY OF DASMARIÑAS, PROVINCE OF
CAVITE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay New Era.* - There is hereby
2 created a barangay to be known as Barangay New Era in the City of
3 Dasmariñas, Province of Cavite.

4 SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* - The plebiscite
5 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC)
6 pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 4-S-91 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan
7 of the Province of Cavite, which ratified the creation of Barangay New Era as
8 proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on August 1, 1993, shall
9 serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section
10 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the "Local
11 Government Code of 1991".

12 SEC. 3. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* - The incumbent barangay
13 officials of Barangay New Era, City of Dasmariñas, Province of Cavite shall
14 continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly
15 elected and qualified.

1 **SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructures and Facilities.*** – All existing public
2 infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
3 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and
4 shall be administered by the new barangay.

5 **SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.*** – Barangay New Era
6 shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
7 Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
8 “Local Government Code of 1991”.

9 **SEC. 6. *Separability Clause.*** – If, for any reason, any part or provision
10 of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions
11 which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect

12 **SEC. 7. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
13 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
