Recommending its approval with amendments.

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government and Electoral Reforms and Peoples' Participation to which was referred House Bill No. 4572, introduced by Representative Manuel S. Agyao, entitled:

"AN ACT

CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY BULANAO NORTE IN THE CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA"

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, line 4, before Section 2 (Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite), insert a new section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES.- THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES OF DESCRIPTION OF BARANGAY BULANAO SHALL CONSIST OF PERMANENT NATURAL BOUNDARIES IDENTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

THAT THE AREA COMPOSED OF PUROK DATO, PUROK DOS, PUROK TRES AND SITIO LINGLINGAY DETACHED FROM BARANGAY BULANAO, TABUK, KALINGA PROVINCE BOUNDED;

ON THE NORTHWEST AND EAST BY LINES 40-41 AND 41-1, 1-2, 2-3, 3-4, 4-5, 5-6, 6-7, 7-8, 8-9, 9-10, 10-11, 11-12, 12-13, 13-14, 14-15, 15-16, 16-17, 17-18, 18-19, 19-20, 20-21, 21-22, 22-23, 23-24, 24-25, 25-26, 26-27, 27-28, 28-29, BY THE NIA IRRIGATION CANAL AND BALIGATAN CREEK RESPECTIVELY;

ON THE NORTHEAST AND EAST BY LINES 29-30, 30-31, 31-32, 32-33, 33-34, 34-35, ACCESS ROAD ADJOINING LOTS NO. 851, 843, 841, 829, 828, 827, 826, 825, 824, 823, 822, 821, 820, 819, 818, 805 AND 1161, AND PLS 93;

ON THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTH BY LINES 35-36, 36-37, 37-38; BULANAO-TUGUEGARAO NATIONAL HIGHWAY ROAD (60 M. WIDE);

ON THE WEST BY LINES 38-40 BY BULANAO-DAGUPAN PROVINCIAL ROAD;

CONTAINING AN AREA OF THREE HUNDRED FIFTY (350) HECTARES APPROXIMATELY AS APPEARING IN THE PLAN."

2. RENUMBER THE SUCCEEDING SECTIONS ACCORDINGLY.



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



AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
BULANAO NORTE IN THE CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF
KALINGA

*Be It enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Bulanao Norte.* – Sitio Bulanao
2 Norte is hereby separated from Barangay Bulanao and constituted into a new
3 barangay to be known as Barangay Bulanao Norte in the City of Tabuk,
4 Province of Kalinga.

5 SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
6 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC)
7 pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2002-002 of the Sangguniang
8 Panlalawigan of the Province of Kalinga in Barangay Bulanao, which ratified
9 the creation of Barangay Bulanao Norte as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board
10 of Canvassers on December 21, 2002 shall serve as a substantial compliance
11 with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
12 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

1 **SEC. 3. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent barangay
2 officials of Barangay Bulanao Norte shall continue to hold office until such
3 time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

4 **SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructures and Facilities.*** – All existing public
5 infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
6 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and
7 shall be administered by the new barangay.

8 **SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.*** – Barangay Bulanao
9 Norte shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
10 Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
11 “Local Government Code of 1991”.

12 **SEC. 6. *Separability Clause.*** – If, for any reason, any part or provision
13 of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or provisions
14 hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and
15 effect.

16 **SEC. 7. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
17 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
18 circulation.
