MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government and Electoral Reforms and Peoples' Participation to which was referred House Bill No. 2087, introduced by Representative Anthony G. Del Rosario, entitled:

"AN ACT

CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY DACUDAO IN THE MUINICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL NORTE"

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, line 4, before Section 2 (Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite), insert a new section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES.- THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES OF BARANGAY DACUDAO SHALL CONSIST OF PERMANENT NATURAL BOUNDARIES IDENTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

BOUNDED ON THE NORTH, ALONG LINES 1-2 TO 32-33, BY BARANGAY DATU BALONG; ON THE EAST, ALONG LINES 33-34 AND 34-35. BY BARANGAY MAMANGAN; ON THE SOUTH-EAST, ALONG LINES 35-36 TO 43-44, BY BARANGAY LIBUTON, ALL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO; AND ON THEWEST AND SOUTH-WEST, ALONG LINES 44-45 TO 50-1, BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF KAPALONG, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL NORTE. AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY DACUDAO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL NORTE

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled

SECTION 1. Creation of Barangay Dacudao. — There is hereby created a barangay to be known as Barangay Dacudao in the Municipality of San Isidro, Province of Davao del Norte.

SEC. 2. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite. — The plebiscite conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2 which was enacted and approved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Davao on May 13, 1987, that ratified the creation of Barangay Dacudao as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on August 30, 1992, shall serve as a substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

SEC. 3. Barangay Officials. — The incumbent elected barangay officials of Barangay Dacudao in the Municipality of San Isidro, Province of

3	SEC. 4. Public Infrastructures and Facilities All existing public
4	infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
5	approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
6	and shall be administered by the new barangay.
7	SEC. 5. Internal Revenue Allotment Share Barangay Dacudao shall
8	be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section
9	285 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government
10	Code of 1991".
11	SEC. 6. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
12	its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation. Approved,
