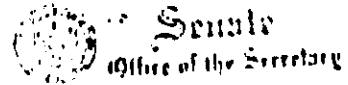


has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved without amendment.







AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
SAN ISIDRO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TITAY, PROVINCE OF
ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay San Isidro.* – There is hereby
2 created a barangay to be known as Barangay San Isidro in the Municipality of
3 Titay, Province of Zamboanga Sibugay.
- 4 SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
5 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC)
6 pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2002-122 dated August 7, 2002 of the
7 Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Zamboanga Sibugay, which
8 ratified the creation of Barangay San Isidro as proclaimed by the Plebiscite
9 Board of Canvassers on April 16, 2005, shall serve as substantial compliance
10 with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160,
11 as amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”.

1 **SEC. 3. Incumbent Barangay Officials.** – The incumbent barangay
2 officials of Barangay San Isidro shall continue to hold office until such time
3 that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

4 **SEC. 4. Public Infrastructures and Facilities.** – All existing public
5 infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
6 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
7 and shall be administered by the new barangay.

8 **SEC. 5. Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.** – Barangay San Isidro
9 shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
10 Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
11 “Local Government Code of 1991”.

12 **SEC. 6. Effectivity.** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
13 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
