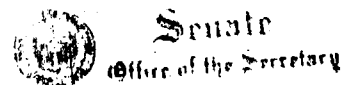


RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON RULES AND MAJORITY LEADER, THE HONORABLE ALAN PETER COMPAÑERO S. CAYETANO, FOR HIS DEDICATED AND OUTSTANDING LEADERSHIP IN STEERING THE DELIBERATIONS OF THE SENATE DURING THE SIXTEENTH CONGRESS

WHEREAS, Senator Alan Peter Compañero S. Cayetano has performed his duties as Majority Leader with fairness, exhibiting at all times his competence, impartiality and keen grasp of parliamentary rules and procedures;

WHEREAS, as the Chamber's hardworking and efficient guide during plenary sessions, he successfully promoted a harmonious relationship among the Members of the Senate, thereby facilitating the smooth and orderly discussions of issues on the floor;

WHEREAS, recognizing the importance of the teaching profession and the role of teachers as the single most influential factor behind a student's performance, he introduced the proposed bill granting public school teachers P9,000 additional compensation and P1,000 medical allowance;

WHEREAS, with his remarkable leadership and brilliant contributions during the deliberation of the Senate, the youthful Senator successfully guided the Members in making the Third Regular Session of the Sixteenth Congress fruitful with the passage of quality and relevant legislations for the benefit of various sectors of society: ***Now, therefore, be it***
