A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES MADRIGAL SINGERS FOR WINNING THE GRAND PRIZE AND MULTIPLE AWARDS IN VARIOUS CATEGORIES OF THE 64th INTERNATIONAL POLYPHONIC COMPETITION GUIDO D'AREZZO HELD LAST AUGUST 24-28, 2016, IN AREZZO, ITALY.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate recognizes Filipinos who show exemplary performance in various fields, in national or international competitions, bringing pride and honor to our country;

WHEREAS, the International Polyphonic Competition Guido d'Arezzo is one of six European choral competitions from which the contenders for the annual European Grand Prix for Choral Singing are chosen;

WHEREAS, at the 64th International Polyphonic Competition Guido d'Arezzo held last August 24-28, 2016 in Arezzo, Italy, the University of the Philippines Madrigal Singers emerged as the winner of the Grand Prize;

WHEREAS, at the 64th International Competition Polyphonic Competition Guido d'Arezzo, the University of the Philippines Madrigal Singers garnered the 1st Prize in the Compulsory Program, Musica Sacra, and Monographic Music Categories, 2nd Prize in Secular Music, and the Special Listening Committee Awards in Folk Song, Pop, and Renaissance Performances;
