has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendment:



1. On page 2, line 11, replace "within thirty (30)" with NOT LATER THAN ONE HUNDRED TWENTY (120).



AN ACT DIVIDING BARANGAY TANGOS IN THE CITY OF NAVOTAS
INTO TWO (2) DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAYS
TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAYS TANGOS NORTH AND
TANGOS SOUTH

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Division of Barangay Tangos.* — Barangay Tangos in the
2 City of Navotas is hereby divided into two (2) distinct and independent
3 barangays to be known as Barangay Tangos North and Barangay Tangos
4 South.

5 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* — The territorial boundaries of each
6 barangay created in the immediately preceding section shall be as follows:

7 (1) Barangay Tangos North

8 "Bounded on the Northwest (NW) and Northeast (NE) by
9 Malabon-Navotas River;

10 On the Southeast (SE) by centreline of Ferry #5r; and

11 On the Southwest (SW) by centrelines of M. Naval Street and Manila
12 Bay;

13 Containing an area of 212,964.02 square meters, more or less."

1 (2) Barangay Tangos South

2 "Bounded on the Northwest (NW) and Northeast (NE) by centreline of
3 M. Naval Street;

4 On the Southeast (SE) by centreline of Manalaysay Street, and by lots
5 4260 and 4261 (Andres Pascual), 4264, 4263, and 4252 all of barangays San
6 Roque, Navotas Cadastral Mapping Mcadm 582-D Case 12; and

7 On the Southwest (SW) by Manila Bay;

8 Containing an area of 151,537.72 square meters, more or less."

9 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The Commission on
10 Elections (COMELEC) shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite to be held in
11 Barangay Tangos in the City of Navotas within thirty (30) days from the
12 effectivity of this Act.

13 The expenses for such plebiscite shall be borne by the City of Navotas.

14 SEC. 4. *Special Election of Barangay Officials.* – The first set of
15 officials of the barangays created under Section 1 hereof shall be elected not
16 later than ninety (90) days from approval by majority of the votes cast in a
17 plebiscite held for the purpose.

18 The COMELEC shall conduct and supervise the special elections to be
19 held in barangays Tangos North and Tangos South in the City of Navotas
20 within sixty (60) days after the ratification of this Act in a plebiscite.

21 The expenses for such special elections shall be borne by the City of
22 Navotas.

23 The incumbent barangay officials of Barangay Tangos shall continue to
24 hold office and administer barangays Tangos North and Tangos South until
25 such time that the officials of the newly created barangays have been duly
26 elected and qualified.

1 *SEC. 5. Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* — All public infrastructure
2 and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this
3 Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be
4 administered by the new barangays.

5 *SEC. 6. Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* — All barangays herein
6 created shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant
7 to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
8 Local Government Code of 1991.

9 *SEC. 7. Effectivity.* — This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
10 its complete publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation in
11 the Philippines.
