MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government; and Electoral and People's Participation, to
which was referred House Bill No. **4923**, introduced by Representative Mylene J. Garcia-
Albano entitled:

**"AN ACT DIVIDING BARANGAY PAMPANGA IN THE CITY OF DAVAO INTO THREE (3)
DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAYS TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY PAMPANGA,
BARANGAY ALFONSO ANGLIONGTO, SR. AND BARANGAY V. HIZON"**

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the
recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. An omnibus amendment, replace "V. Hizon" with "VICENTE HIZON SR."

- On page 1, line 4;
- On page 2, line 19;
- On page 3, line 11;
- On page 3, line 17; and
- On page 3, line 25.

2. On pages 1-2, delete lines 8-4 and in lieu thereof, insert the ff:

On the Southeast (NE), pts. 9 to 11, by Barangay of Sasa, Case 16;
On the Southwest (SE), pts. 12 to 21, by the shoreline of Davao Gulf; and
On the Northwest (SW), pts. 22 to pt. 1 by Barangay Vicente Hizon Sr., Case 14.

PAMPANGA, BARANGAY ALFONSO ANGLIONGTO, SR. AND BARANGAY [V]
VICENTE HIZON SR."



AN ACT DIVIDING BARANGAY PAMPANGA IN THE CITY OF
DAVAO INTO THREE (3) DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT
BARANGAYS TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY PAMPANGA,
BARANGAY ALFONSO ANGLIONGTO, SR., AND BARANGAY
V. HIZON

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Division of Barangay Pampanga.* – Barangay Pampanga
2 in the City of Davao is hereby divided into three (3) distinct and independent
3 barangays to be known as: (1) Barangay Pampanga; (2) Barangay Alfonso
4 Angliongto, Sr.; and (3) Barangay V. Hizon.

5 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of each
6 barangay created in the immediately preceding section shall be as follows:

7 (1) Barangay Pampanga

8 “Bounded on the North by the Davao International Airpor
9 Runway;

10 On the West by Barangay Vicente Hizon, Sr.;

11 On the South by the coastline of the Davao Gulf; and

1 On the West by Barangay Sasa, Doña Pilar Road and
2 Rodriguez Drive comprising of Doña Asuncion I, Doña Asuncion
3 II, San Roque, Don Lorenzo, Sto. Domingo II, D.A. Homes and
4 COACO Beach."

5 (2) Barangay Alfonso Angliongto, Sr.

6 "Bounded on the Northwest by Belisario Road, Belisario
7 Fence, Te Property and NHA Buhangin;

8 On the North by Barangay Cabantian and Phases 1 and 3 of La
9 Verna Subdivision;

10 On the West by Carmelite Road;

11 On the South by J.P. Laurel Avenue; and

12 On the East by Nova Tierra Village, Fortune Homes and
13 Insular Village Phase 1 comprising of La Verna Subdivision
14 Phase 2, Diamond Village Phases 1 and 2, Belisario Subdivision,
15 Saint Anthony Village, Mamay Village, Vincent Heights, Roseville,
16 Lea Subdivision, Guadalupe Village, Summer Hill, Pulang Lupa,
17 Liceralde Subdivision, Golden Homes, JLA Subdivision and
18 Victoria Heights Subdivision."

19 (3) Barangay V. Ilizon

20 "Bounded on the North by the Davao International Airport
21 Runway;

22 On the West by Barangay Alfonso Angliongto, Sr. and
23 Barangay Lapu-Lapu;

24 On the South by the coastline of the Davao Gulf;

25 On the Southeast by J.P. Laurel Avenue (a.k.a.
26 Davao-Agusan Road) and the Insular Creek;

1 On the East by Doña Asuncion Road; and

2 On the Northeast by Doña Asuncion comprising of Insular
3 Village I, Insular Village II, Fortune Executive Homes, Nova Tierra
4 Village, PEHA Subdivision, PEHO, Belen Homes, Sto. Domingo I,
5 Donas Ville, Model Homes, Lizada Beach Club and Mountain
6 Dew.”

7 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
8 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in
9 Barangay Pampanga pursuant to City Ordinance No. 00161-03 of the
10 Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Davao, which ratified the creation of
11 Barangay Alfonso Angliongto, Sr. and of Barangay V. Hizon as proclaimed by
12 the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on July 25, 2004, shall serve as substantial
13 compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act
14 No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of
15 1991”.

16 SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay
17 officials of barangays Pampanga, Alfonso Angliongto, Sr., and V. Hizon,
18 City of Davao shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors
19 have been duly elected and qualified.

20 SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
21 infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
22 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
23 and shall be administered by the new barangays.

24 SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangays Pampanga,
25 Alfonso Angliongto, Sr. and V. Hizon shall be entitled to Internal Revenue
26 Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
27 amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”.

1 SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.* — If, for any reason, any part or
2 provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or
3 provisions which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and
4 effect.

5 SEC. 8. *Effectivity.* — This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
6 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
