AN ACT

TO AMEND CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7431, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY ACT OF 1992", AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. Paragraphs (f) and (g) of Section 3 of RA No. 7431 are hereby deleted
2	and paragraphs (h) and (i) of the same Section are correspondingly renumbered as (f) and (g)
3	as follows:

In addition, a new paragraph (h) under Section 3 shall be included, to read as follows:

(H) AIPO REFERS TO THE ACCREDITED AND INTEGRATED PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION OF X-RAY TECHNOLOGISTS AND RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS THAT THE BOARD HAS ACCREDITED, **SUBJECT** TO THE **APPROVAL** COMMISSION, THE AS ONE AND ONLY ACCREDITED INTEGRATED **NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF** X-RAY TECHNOLOGISTS AND RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS.

SEC. 2. Section 6 of RA 7431 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Creation of the Board of Radiologic Technology.- There is hereby created a PROFESSIONAL REGULATORY Board of Radiologic Technology which shall be composed of a Chairman and four (4) Members, all of whom shall be appointed by the President of the Philippines upon the recommendation of the Professional Regulation Commission. The Commission shall recommend three (3) radiologic technologists from a list OF FIVE (5) NOMINEES PER VACANCY to be submitted by the [association] AIPO of X-RAY TECHNOLOGISTS AND radiologic technologists; [one (1) radiologist from a list to be submitted by the association of radiologists; and one (1) medical physicist from a list to be submitted by the association of medical physicist: Provided, however, That the said association is accredited in accordance with Presidential Decree No. 223:] Provided, [further,] That each person whose name is submitted shall possess the qualifications prescribed in Section 7 of this Act."

FOREIGN RECIPROCITY.- NO FOREIGN X-RAY TECHNOLOGIST OR RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGIST SHALL BE GIVEN A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION (COR) AND PROFESSIONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD (PIC) OR BE ENTITLED TO ANY OF THE PRIVILEGES UNDER THIS ACT UNLESS THE COUNTRY OF WHICH THE **FOREIGN** X-RAY **TECHNOLOGIST** OR RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGIST IS A SUBJECT OR CITIZEN OF SPECIFICALLY PERMITS FILIPINO X-RAY TECHNOLOGISTS OR RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS TO PRACTICE WITHIN ITS TERRITORIAL LIMITS ON THE SAME BASIS AS THE SUBJECTS OR CITIZENS OF SAID COUNTRY OR STATE.

SEC. 9. Section 25 of RA 7431 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 25. FEES. APPLICANTS FOR EXAMINATION, REGISTRATION, REPLACEMENT OF LOST OR DESTROYED COR OR PIC OR REISSUANCE OF REVOKED COR SHALL PAY THE CORRESPONDING FEES AS MAY BE PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSION. [Unless otherwise fixed by the Commission, each examinee or registrant shall pay the following fees:

- (a) For application for examination P350.00
- 23 (b) For registration after passing the board examinations P250.00
- 24 (c) For registration without examination P250.00
- 25 (d) For replacement of lost or destroyed certificate of registration P100.00

(e) For reissuance of revoked certificate P100.00]

SEC. 10. A new Section is hereby inserted after Section 25 to read as:

"SECTION 26. INTEGRATION OF THE X-RAY TECHNOLOGY AND RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY PROFESSIONS. THE X-RAY TECHNOLOGY AND RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY PROFESSIONS SHALL BE INTEGRATED INTO ONE (1) NATIONAL ORGANIZATION WHICH SHALL BE ACCREDITED BY THE BOARD, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL BY THE COMMISSION, AS THE AIPO OF XRAY TECHNOLOGISTS AND RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS. ALL XRAY **TECHNOLOGISTS TECHNOLOGISTS** AND RADIOLOGIC DULY REGISTERED WITH THE BOARD SHALL AUTOMATICALLY BECOME MEMBERS OF THE AIPO, AND SHALL RECEIVE THE BENEFITS AND PRIVILEGES AS WELL AS BE SUBJECT TO THE DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS APPERTAINING TO SUCH MEMBERSHIP PAYMENT OF THE REQUIRED FEES AND DUES. MEMBERSHIP IN THE AIPO SHALL NOT BE A BAR TO MEMBERSHIP IN OTHER ASSOCIATIONS OF XRAY TECHNOLOGISTS AND RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS."

SEC. 11. Section 26 of RA 7431 is hereby further amended to read as:

"Section 26. Penal Provisions. – Any person who shall practice **X-RAY TECHNOLOGY OR RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY** in the Philippines, within the meaning of this Act, with any of the following attending circumstances shall, upon conviction by final judgment, be punished with a fine of not less than Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00) not more than Forty Thousand Pesos (P40,000.00), or by

imprisonment of not less than one (1) year nor more than six (6) years, or both, at the 1 2 discretion of the court: 3 (a) x x x (b) x x x4 5 (c) x x x6 $(d) \times \times \times$ 7 (e) x x x (f) x x x8 9

SEC. 12. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, decrees, orders, and other issuances, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 13. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation in the country or in the Official Gazette.
