- AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE PHILIPPINE SPACE DEVELOPMENT AND UTILIZATION POLICY AND CREATING THE PHILIPPINE SPACE AGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- 1 SECTION 1. Short Title. This Act shall be known as
- 2 the "Philippine Space Act".
- 3 SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared
- 4 the policy of the State:
- 5 (a) To safeguard Philippine sovereignty, territorial
- 6 integrity, Philippine interest, and the right to self-

- 1 determination as mandated by Article II, Section 7 of the
- 2 1987 Constitution;
- 3 (b) To support and commit to the development,
- 4 application and utilization of science and technology
- 5 (S&T) that will foster patriotism and nationalism and
- 6 accelerate social progress, such as the development of
- 7 space technology and applications for its security and for
- 8 the benefit of its citizens;
- 9 (c) To ensure access to space and its environs as a
- 10 sovereign right in the promotion of national security
- 11 towards the attainment and protection of national interest:
- 12 (d) To recognize that there is an urgent need to create a
- 13 coherent and unified strategy for space development and
- 14 utilization to keep up with other nations in terms of space S&T;
- 15 (e) To ensure that the Philippines has official
- 16 representation in the international space community for
- 17 establishing cooperation agreements and linkages on space
- 18 development; and
- 19 (f) To ensure that the Philippines abides by the
- 20 various international space treaties and principles

- 1 promulgated by the United Nations and is an active
- 2 participant in the international space community,
- 3 including international rules and procedures concerning
- 4 the Outer Space Treaty and Liability Convention, among
- 5 others.
- 6 SEC. 3. Definition of Terms. As used in this Act the
- 7 following terms shall mean:
- 8 (a) PhilSA refers to the Philippine Space Agency
- 9 created by virtue of this Act:
- 10 (b) Space Science and Technology Applications
- 11 (SSTAs) refer to the scientific principles and their
- 12 applications to space science, engineering and other allied
- 13 fields; and
- 14 (c) Satellites include all objects launched into earth
- orbit and artificial objects to be placed in orbit of celestial
- 16 bodies for the conduct of space exploration.
- 17 SEC. 4. The Philippine Space Development and
- 18 Utilization Policy. The Philippine Space Development
- 19 and Utilization Policy, or the Philippine Space Policy, will

- 1 serve as the country's primary strategic roadmap for space
- 2 development and will embody the country's central goal of
- 3 becoming a space-capable and space-faring nation within
- 4 the next decade. It shall focus on areas of SSTA that would
- 5 address national issues, promote the efficient utilization of
- 6 space assets and resources, establish capacity-building
- 7 measures for human resources development, strengthen
- 8 national defense, and enhance international cooperation.
- 9 SEC. 5. Framework of the Space Policy. The
- 10 Philippine Space Policy will focus on six (6) Key
- 11 Development Areas (KDAs) for SSTA development to
- 12 ensure the State's sustained progress:
- 13 (a) National Security and Development The
- 14 Philippines will focus on space applications that can
- 15 preserve and enhance the country's national security and
- 16 promote development that is beneficial to all Filipinos;
- 17 (b) Hazard Management and Climate Studies The
- 18 Philippines will develop and utilize space S&T applications
- 19 to enhance its hazard management and disaster mitigation

1 strategy as well as ensure the nation's resiliency to climate

- 2 change;
- 3 (c) Space Research and Development To spur rapid
  4 scientific growth, the Philippines will focus on conducting
- 5 research and development (R&D) endeavors in vital areas
- 6 of space science, technology and allied fields;
- 7 (d) Space Industry Capacity Building The
- 8 Philippines will create a robust and thriving space
- 9 industry to support the country's space program through
- 10 private sector involvement and cooperation;
- 11 (e) Space Education and Awareness The Philippines
- 12 aims to establish a sustainable pool of trained space
- 13 scientists, engineers and communicators that will be
- 14 critical for the country's future space program and
- 15 increasing public awareness on its value and benefits; and
- 16 (f) International Cooperation Through international
- 17 partnerships and collaborations, the Philippines will
- 18 become a key player in the ASEAN and global space
- 19 community by providing significant contributions and
- 20 capabilities on space S&T applications.

- 1 Sec. 6. Creation of the Philippine Space Agency
- 2 (PhilSA). A Philippine Space Agency, hereinafter
- 3 referred to as the PhilSA, is hereby established as the
- 4 central government agency addressing all national issues
- 5 and activities related to space S&T applications.
- 6 SEC. 7. Mandate. The PhilSA shall be the primary
- 7 policy, planning, coordinating, implementing, and
- 8 administrative entity of the Executive Branch of the
- 9 government that will plan, develop, and promote the
- 10 national space program in line with the Philippine Space
- 11 Policy.
- 12 SEC. 8. Powers and Functions. The PhilSA shall
- 13 exercise the following powers and functions:
- 14 I. Policy, Planning and Coordination
- 15 (a) Assist the State in the creation, development and
- 16 implementation of national and international space
- 17 policies;
- 18 (b) Plan, direct, manage and implement programs
- 19 and projects relating to scientific space research and
- 20 development and the application of space technology:

1	(c) Take hold of money, securities or other personal or
2	movable property by gift or bequest and expend,
3	administer or dispose of any such money, securities or
4	property subject to the terms, if any, on which the gift or
5	bequest was made in such manner as shall best promote
6	the PhilSA's objectives;
7	(d) Implement the Philippine Space Development and
8	Utilization Policy;
9	(e) Coordinate all space activities of various sectors
10	and stakeholders in the Philippines, in accordance with
11	existing laws; and
12	(f) Provide appropriate and accurate advice to the
13	President of the Philippines and other government
14	agencies on space-related issues and concerns.
15	II. Improved Public Access and Resource-Sharing
16	(a) Develop, construct, acquire, manage, maintain
17	and operate space research, development and operation
18	facilities and systems on behalf of the Philippine
19	Government for use of various government agencies and
20	other stakeholders; and

1	(b) Assist departments and other agencies of the
2	State, as well as the private sector, in the utilization o
3	SSTA and data/information to aid in the performance o
4	their respective mandates and duties.
5	III. Research and Development
6	(a) Perform basic and applied R&D relating to SSTA
7	in collaboration with universities, industries and other
8	institutions;
9	(b) Design, develop and construct space systems and
10	facilities necessary thereof, as well as launch, track and
11	operate the satellites on behalf of the Philippine
12	Government; and
13	(c) Promote the growth of space S&T through R&D.
14	IV. Education and Capacity Building
15	(a) Establish programs that would develop space
16	education and promote public awareness;
17	(b) Provide grants and contributions in support of
18	programs or projects relating to scientific or industrial

space R&D and application of space technology; and

1	(c) Frovide services and facilities for the use by
2	entities conducting academic R&D relating to SSTA.
3	V. Industry Development
4	(a) Promote the development of a robust and vibrant
5	local space industry and economy;
6	(b) Promote the transfer and diffusion of space
7	technology throughout the Philippine industry;
8	(c) Encourage the commercial exploitation of space
9	capabilities, technology, information, facilities and
10	systems;
11	(d) License, sell or otherwise make available any
12	patent, copyright, industrial design, trademark, trade
13	secret or other like property controlled; and
14	(e) Disseminate the results of R&D activities and
15	promote the utilization thereof, except when information is
16	deemed confidential for national welfare and security and
17	for the protection of intellectual property rights.
18	VI. International Cooperation
19	(a) Cooperate with space-related agencies of other

countries in the peaceful use and development of space;

1	(b)	Maintain	a	national	registry	of	space	objects	in
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- 2 accordance with the United Nations Convention on
- 3 Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space and
- 4 other international guidelines;
- 5 (c) Enter into contracts, memoranda of
- 6 understanding/agreement or other arrangements in behalf
- 7 of the State, in consultation with the Department of
- 8 Foreign Affairs and/or other concerned agencies;
- 9 (d) Establish and maintain linkages with other
- 10 national space agencies and organizations; and
- 11 (e) Represent the Philippines in the United Nations
- 12 Committee on the Peaceful Use of Outer Space and other
- 13 similar space-related forums, assemblies and
- 14 organizations.
- 15 SEC. 9. Composition. The PhilSA shall be an
- 16 attached agency of the Office of the President for purposes
- 17 of policy and program coordination, to ensure alignment in
- 18 national policies and priorities. It shall be headed by a
- 19 Director General. The PhilSA proper shall be composed of
- 20 the Office of the Director General, the Offices of the

1	Deputy Director General and various divisions to be
2	created as deemed necessary.
3	SEC. 10. Director General of the PhilSA The
4	Director General shall have the rank and compensation of
5	a Cabinet Secretary and shall be appointed by the
6	President, subject to the confirmation by the Commission
7	on Appointments. The Director General shall have the
8	following functions:
9	(a) Provide executive direction and supervision over
10	the entire operations of the PhilSA and its attached units;
11	(b) Establish policies and standards for the effective,
12	efficient and economical operation of the PhilSA, in
13	accordance with the programs of the government;
14	(c) Review and approve requests for financial and
15	manpower resources of all operating offices of the PhilSA;
16	(d) Designate and appoint officers and employees of
17	the PhilSA, excluding the Deputy Directors, in accordance
18	with the civil service laws, rules and regulations;

(e) Exercise disciplinary powers over officers and

employees of the PhilSA in accordance with law, including

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- 1 their investigation and the designation of a committee or
- 2 officer to conduct such investigation:
- 3 (f) Coordinate with other departments, agencies and
- 4 public and private interest groups, including
- 5 nongovernment organizations (NGOs) and people's
- 6 organizations (POs) on PhilSA policies and initiatives;
- 7 (g) Prepare and submit to the President through the
- 8 Department of Budget and Management (DBM) an
- 9 estimate of the necessary expenditures during the next
- 10 fiscal year, on the basis of the reports and estimates
- 11 submitted by the divisions and offices under him/her:
- 12 (h) Serve as a member of the Government
- 13 Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) as established by
- 14 Republic Act No. 9184:
- 15 (i) Serve as the Presidential Adviser on Space
- 16 Matters and advise the President on the promulgation of
- 17 executive and administrative orders and formulation of
- 18 regulatory and legislative proposals on matters pertaining
- 19 to SSTA development;

1	(j) Formulate such rules and regulations and exercise
2	such other powers as may be required to implement the
3	objectives of this Act; and
4	(k) Perform such other tasks as may be provided by
5	law or assigned by the President.
6	SEC. 11. Deputy Director General The Director
7	General shall be assisted by three (3) Deputy Director
8	General with the rank and compensation of a Department
9	Undersecretary who shall be appointed by the President
10	upon the recommendation of the Director General:
11	Provided, That two (2) of the Deputy Director General
12	shall be career executive officers.
13	SEC. 12. Qualifications No person shall be
14	appointed Director General or Deputy Director General of
15	the PhilSA unless he or she is a citizen and resident of the
16	Philippines, of good moral character, of proven integrity,
17	with an advanced degree in Space Science, Astronomy,
18	Physics, Engineering or related fields of study, with at
19	least five (5) years of competence and expertise in any of

the following: astrophysics, space science, aerospace

1	engineering,	space	systems	engineering,	remote	sensing
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- 2 space industry, or human capital development in the SSTA
- 3 sector.
- 4 SEC. 13. Philippine Space Council. A Philippine
- 5 Space Council (PSC) is hereby created as the principal
- 6 advisory body for the coordination and integration of
- 7 policies, programs and resources affecting space S&T
- 8 applications.
- 9 (a) The PSC shall be composed of the following:
- 10 (1) President of the Philippines Chairperson
- 11 (2) Secretary of Science and Technology Vice
- 12 Chairperson
- 13 (3) Secretary of National Defense Vice Chairperson
- 14 (4) Chair of Senate Committee on Science and
- 15 Technology Member
- 16 (5) Chair of House Committee on Science and Technology -
- 17 Member
- 18 (6) Director General of the National Economic Development
- 19 Authority Member
- 20 (7) Secretary of Finance Member

1	(8) Secretary of Foreign Affairs – Member
2	(9) Secretary of Agriculture – Member
3	(10) Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources
4	- Member
5	(11) Secretary of Trade and Industry – Member
6	(12) Secretary of Information and Communications
7	${\bf Technology-Member}$
8	The President may designate the Executive Secretary
9	to preside over the meetings of the PSC in the President's
10	absence.
11	(b) Functions of the Philippine Space Council. The
12	PSC shall have the following functions:
13	(1) Recommend and approve the implementation of
14	Philippine space policies in accordance with international
15	conventions;
16	(2) Ensure appropriate allocation of resources in
17	support to the mandates of the PhilSA; and
18	(3) Approve strategic directions and decisions for the
19	implementation of the PhilSA.

1	(c) Secretariat to the PSC. The Director General of
2	the PhilSA shall serve as Head Secretariat to the PSC
3	together with the support staff of the PhilSA.
4	Sec. 14. Transfer of Astronomical and Space-related
5	Functions To consolidate the functions of PhilSA, the
6	following shall be transferred from their parent agency:
7	(a) Philippines Space Science Education Program of
8	the Science Education Institute, Department of Science
9	and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI)
10	(b) The transfer of funds, functions, assets,
11	equipment, properties, transactions, personnel of the
12	affected agencies, among others, shall be completed within
13	specified period to enable such transfer smoothly from
14	their parent agencies to the PhilSA; and
15	(c) The filling up of positions in the PhilSA shall be
16	subject to the provisions of Republic Act No. 6656, or the
17	Security of Tenure of the Personnel.
18	Nothing in this Act shall diminish the functions and

responsibilities of the support agencies.

1 SEC. 15. Separation and Retirement from Service. -2 Employees who are separated from service within six (6) months from the effectivity of this Act as a result of 3 consolidation and/or reorganization under the provisions of 4 5 this Act shall receive separation benefits to which they may be entitled under Executive Order No. 366, series of 6 2004: Provided, That those who are qualified to retire 7 8 under existing retirement laws shall be allowed to retire 9 and receive retirement benefits to which they may be 10 entitled under applicable laws and issuances. 11 SEC. 16. Structure and Staffing Pattern. - Subject to approval of the Department of Budget and 12 Management (DBM), the PhilSA shall determine its 13 14 organizational structure and create new divisions or units as it may deem necessary, and shall appoint officers and 15 employees of the PhilSA in accordance with the civil 16 service laws, rules and regulations. 17 18 SEC. 17. Official Site of PhilSA. - A land area 19 equivalent to at least thirty (30) hectares out of the vast of land which are under the administration of the Bases 20

- 1 Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA) within the
- 2 Clark Special Economic Zone in Pampanga and Tarlac,
- 3 shall be allocated exclusively for the PhilSA office and its
- 4 research facilities: Provided, That the PhilSA shall
- 5 establish additional offices, research facilities, and launch
- 6 sites in strategic areas as it may deem necessary: Provided,
- 7 further, That the boundaries and technical descriptions of
- 8 these land areas shall be determined by an actual and joint
- 9 group survey.
- 10 SEC. 18. Magna Carta. Qualified employees of the
- 11 PhilSA and its attached units shall be covered by Republic
- 12 Act No. 8439, otherwise known as "Magna Carta for
- 13 Scientists, Engineers, Researchers and other Science and
- 14 Technology Personnel in the Government".
- 15 SEC. 19. Annual Report. The PhilSA shall submit to
- 16 the President and to both Houses of Congress, not later
- 17 than the 30th of March of every year following the
- 18 effectivity of this Act, a report giving a detailed account of
- 19 the status of the implementation of this Act and
- 20 recommended legislation, where applicable and necessary.

1 SEC. 20. Funds of the PhilSA. - The funds of the 2 PhilSA shall consist of: (a) The annual General Appropriation for the PhilSA: 3 4 and 5 (b) Income, fees, royalties and other revenues obtained from any other sources. 6 7 The funds shall be administered by the Director 8 General of the PhilSA in accordance with existing government budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and 9 10 regulations. 11 SEC. 21. Use of Income. - The budget of PhilSA, based 12 on an annual appropriation from Congress, shall ensure 13 that it has the financial and human resources necessary to 14 fulfill its assigned responsibilities under this Act. The 15 PhilSA shall also be authorized to use one-hundred percent 16 (100%) of its income, donations, bequests, grants, and all 17 sums which may be appropriated for upgrading its physical and human resources, for the conduct of its activities, and 18

for the augmentation of its budget in case of shortfalls.

Seventy-five percent (75%) of its income shall be retained

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- 1 for the upgrading of its equipment and physical facilities
- 2 and the remaining twenty-five percent (25%) shall be
- 3 remitted to the National Treasury. The PhilSA may also
- 4 solicit, receive and retain donations, bequests, and grants.
- 5 SEC. 22. Philippine Space Development Fund. There
- 6 is hereby created the Philippine Space Development Fund
- 7 to be used exclusively for the PhilSA. The Philippine Space
- 8 Development Fund shall be administered by the Director
- 9 General of the PhilSA in accordance with existing
- 10 government budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and
- 11 regulations. The Philippine Space Development Fund shall
- 12 be sourced from the following:
- 13 (a) The amount of Ten billion pesos
- 14 (P10,000,000,000.00) to be taken from the share of the
- 15 National Government in the gross income of the Philippine
- 16 Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR) and the
- 17 Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA) for
- 18 five (5) years after the effectivity of this Act, an amount of
- 19 Two billion pesos (P2,000,000,000.00) per year shall be
- 20 released to the PhilSA. The entire amount of Ten billion

- 1 pesos (P10,000,000,000.00), including any interest income
- thereon, shall be used exclusively for capital outlay;
- 3 (b) Income from specialized products, services, and
- 4 royalties produced by the PhilSA; and
- 5 (c) Loans, contributions, grants, bequests, gifts, and
- 6 donations whether from local or foreign sources: Provided,
- 7 That acceptance of grants, bequests, contributions and
- 8 donations from foreign governments shall be subject to the
- 9 approval of the President upon the recommendation of the
- 10 Director General of the PhilSA through the PSC.
- 11 SEC. 23. National Registry of Space Objects. In
- 12 accordance to the United Nations Convention on
- 13 Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space, the
- 14 PhilSA shall maintain a National Registry of Space Objects
- 15 which lists all space objects launched under the
- 16 responsibility of the Philippines as the Launching State.
- 17 The PhilSA shall furnish the United Nation Office for
- 18 Outer Space Affairs with information contained in the
- 19 National Registry of Space Objects as required under the
- 20 Registration Convention.

1	SEC. 24. Liability of the Philippines for National
2	Space Objects In accordance with the United National
3	Convention on International Liability for Damage Caused
4	by Space Objects and other similar international laws, the
5	Philippine Government shall take responsibility for
6	damages caused by space objects registered in the
7	Philippines' National Registry of Space Objects. This shall
8	take into effect upon ratification of the Liability
9	Convention and Registration Convention by the Philippine
10	Government.
11	SEC. 25. Appropriations The sum of One billion
12	pesos (P1,000,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated as initia
13	operating fund of the PhilSA, taken from the current fisca
14	year's appropriation of the Office of the President
15	Thereafter, the amount needed for the operation and
16	maintenance of the PhilSA shall be included in the Genera
17	Appropriations Act.
18	SEC. 26. Implementing Rules and Regulations.
19	Within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this Act

20 PhilSA, in coordination with DBM, Civil Service

Commission and other relevant government agencies, shall 1 promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the 2 3 effective implementation of this Act. 4 SEC. 27. Separability Clause. - Should any provision herein be declared unconstitutional, the same shall not 5 6 affect the validity of the other provisions of this Act. 7 SEC. 28. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, orders, rules, and regulations or other issuances or parts 8 9 inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby 10 repealed or modified accordingly. SEC. 29. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect 11 12 fifteen (15) days after publication in the Official Gazette or in any two (2) newspapers of general 13
