EXPLANATORY NOTE

Election offenses have long been a reality in Philippine politics. In fact, our people have witnessed massive incidents of election offenses in the past which has eroded our people's confidence on the sanctity of our election process. This bill seeks to give more teeth to our existing law by increasing the penalties provided for under Section 46 of Republic Act 8189. This should help deter deceitful individuals from committing election fraud.

In order to address the upsurge of election related offenses as well as regain our people's faith in the election process, approval of this bill is strongly recommended.

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 46 OF REPUBLIC ACT 8189 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE VOTER'S REGISTRATION ACT OF 1996" BY INCREASING THE PENALTY PROVIDED AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Philippines and the House of Representatives in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Article 46 of Republic Act 8189 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 46. Penalties. — Any person found guilty of any Election offense under this Act shall be punished with imprisonment of not less than SIX (6) [one (1)] year\$ but not more than TWELVE (12) [six (6)] years and shall not be subject to probation. In addition, the guilty party shall be sentenced to suffer disqualification to hold public office and deprivation of the right of suffrage. If he is a foreigner, he shall be deported after the prison term has been served. Any political party found guilty shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than FIVE [One] hundred thousand pesos (P500,000.00) [(P100, 000)] but not more than ONE MILLION [Five hundred thousand] pesos (P1,000,000.00) [(P500,000.00)]."

- Sec. 2. **Repealing Clause.** All laws, decrees, ordinances, rules and regulations, executive or administrative orders, and other presidential issuance inconsistent with this Act, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.
- Sec.3. *Effectivity.* This Act shall take effect after (15) days following its publication in at least (2) newspapers of general circulation.
