RESOLUTION

URGING THE COMMITTEE ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS, INNOVATION, AND FUTURES THINKING TO CONDUCT A HEARING, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE EFFECTS OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC ON THE FUTURE OF HEALTH SERVICE DELIVERY IN THE COUNTRY FOR THE NEW NORMAL AND IN PREPARATION FOR FUTURE PANDEMICS AND OTHER HEALTH EMERGENCIES

- **WHEREAS,** the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic carry a major shift in the country's health service delivery, compelling the government to re-examine its health service practices as the world waits for a vaccine;
- **WHEREAS**, with the onset of the New Normal, existing practices and systems in health service delivery, such as physical clinics, face-to-face triage, and paper-based prescriptions, may be ineffective in responding to the need for stricter respiratory hygiene and physical distancing measures;
- WHEREAS, the impact of COVID-19 and the necessity to adapt to the New Normal urge the country to employ futures thinking as an essential strategy in dealing with pervasive issues that have long affected the country's healthcare system, which in turn impact other sectors, negatively affecting outcomes ranging beyond health;

WHEREAS, futures thinking is a method for informed reflections on possible
futures of various aspects of life, by bringing into focus the scope of connection among
issues and their potential impacts and implications; ¹

WHEREAS, various sectors of society, such as the academe, the private sector and the government, need to collaborate and explore possible outcomes, emerging ideas and innovative opportunities and strategies for the future of health service delivery;

WHEREAS, it is essential for these sectors to formally converge through an enabling platform that could inform policies in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and to future health emergencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, to urge the Committee on Sustainable Development Goals, Innovation, and Futures Thinking, to conduct a hearing, in aid of legislation, on the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on the future of health service delivery in the country for the new normal and in preparation for future pandemics and other health emergencies.
