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PURPOSES" Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

THEREFOR.

FOR ELECTORAL REFORMS,

7166, ENTITLED "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SYNCHRONIZED NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTIONS

AUTHORIZING

FOR

AND

SECTION 1. Section 13 of Republic Act No. 7166 is hereby 1 amended to read as follows: 2 "SEC. 13. Authorized Expenses of Candidates and 3 Political Parties. - The aggregate amount that a candidate or registered political party may spend for 5 election campaign shall be as follows: 6 "(a) For candidates - [Ten pesos (P10.00)] 7 FIFTY PESOS (P50.00) for President, [and]

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Vice-President AND SENATORS; and for other candidates, [Three pesos (P3.00)] THIRTY PESOS (P30.00) for every voter currently registered in the constituency where [he] THEY ARE SEEKING TO BE ELECTED AND HAVE filed [his] A certificate of candidacy[: Provided, That, a candidate without any political party and without support from any political party may be allowed to spend Five pesos (P5.00) for every such voter] FOR; and

"(b) For political parties — [Five pesos (P5.00)] FIFTY PESOS (P50.00) FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE NATIONAL CANDIDATES AND THIRTY PESOS (P30.00) FOR LOCAL CANDIDATES for every voter [currently registered in the constituency or constituencies where it has official candidates].

"Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, any contribution in cash or in kind to any candidate or political party or coalition of parties for campaign purposes, duly reported to the Commission, shall not be subject to the payment of [any gift] DONOR'S tax.

"EVERY SIX (6) **YEARS** FROM THE EFFECTIVITY OF THIS ACT, THE COMMISSION SHALL, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE BANGKO SENTRAL NG PILIPINAS. NATIONAL ECONOMIC THE AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AND THE PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY. SHALL ADJUST THE

4	SEC. 2. If any portion or provision of this Act is declared							
5	unconstitutional, the remainder of this Act or any provision not							
6	affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.							
7	SEC. 3. All other laws, acts, presidential decrees, executive							
8	orders, issuances, presidential proclamations, rules and regulations,							
.9	or parts thereof, which are contrary to and inconsistent with any							
10.	provision of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified							
11	accordingly.							
12	SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its							
13	publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of							
14	general circulation.
