AN ACT

## ESTABLISHING CAMPUSES OF THE CEBU TECHOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY (CTU) IN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF LILOAN AND BORBON, PROVINCE OF CEBU, TO BE KNOWN RESPECTIVELY AS THE CTU-LILOAN CAMPUS AND CTU-BORBON CAMPUS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled: 

SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "Cebu Technological University (CTU)-Liloan Campus and Cebu Technological University (CTU)-Borbon Campus Act".

SEC. 2. There are hereby established campuses of the Cebu Technological University (CTU), hereinafter referred to as the University, in the Municipalities of Liloan and Borbon, Province of Cebu, to be known respectively as the CTU-Liloan Campus and CTU-Borbon Campus.

SEC. 3. The CTU-Liloan Campus and CTU-Borbon Campus shall primarily provide shortterm, technical-vocational, undergraduate, and graduate courses within their areas of competency and specialization, pursuant to their mandate, and according to their-capabilities as the Board of Regents, hereinafter referred to as the Board, may deem necessary for the accomplishment of their objectives. and those which respond to the human resources development needs of the Province of Cebu and Region VII.

The CTU-Liloan Campus and CTU-Borbon Campus are also mandated to undertake research and extension services, and to provide progressive leadership in these areas.

19 SEC. 4. The CTU-Liloan Campus and CTU-Borbon Campus shall be headed by Campus 20 Administrators who shall render full-time services and be appointed or designated by the Board upon the recommendation of the search committee and the President of the University. Such 21

- appointment or designation shall be subject to the guidelines, qualifications, and standards set by
  the Board.
- 4 SEC. 5. The establishment of the CTU-Liloan Campus and the CTU-Borbon Campus 5 shall ensure that the minimum requirements for their operation and program offerings have been 6 complied with, as duly prescribed by the Commission on Higher Education.

8 SEC. 6. All assets, real and personal, personnel, and records of the CTU-Liloan Campus 9 and CTU-Borbon Campus, as well as liabilities or obligations, are hereby transferred to the 10 University. The positions, rights, and security of tenure of faculty members and personnel 11 employed at the CTU-Liloan Campus and CTU-Borbon Campus under existing laws prior to the 12 integration to the university shall be respected.

All parcels of land belonging to the government occupied by the CTU-Liloan Campus and CTU-Borbon Campus are hereby declared to be the property of the University and shall be titled under that name: *Provided*, That should the University cease to exist or be abolished or should such aforementioned parcels of land be no longer needed by the University, the same shall revert to the concerned local government unit or to the Republic of the Philippines, as the case may be.

SEC. 7. The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the "Higher
 Education Modernization Act of 1997", shall form part of this Act, and together, shall serve as
 the governing charter of the University.

SEC. 8. All other powers, functions, privileges, responsibilities, and limitations to state
 universities and their officials under existing laws shall be deemed granted to or imposed upon
 the University and its officials, whenever appropriate.

SEC. 9. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included in
 the annual General Appropriations Act.

32 SEC. 10. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or
 33 unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and
 a4 effect.

36 SEC. 11. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations contrary
 37 to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed or modified accordingly.
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39 SEC. 12. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
 40 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
