## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY TALIPAPA, QUEZON CITY, METRO MANILA TO BE KNOWN AS TALIPAPA NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

Article II, Section 17 of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall give priority to education. The Constitution further declares that the State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all.

Residents of Barangay Talipapa, Quezon City have been requesting for the establishment a high school in their barangay. Barangay Talipapa has an elementary school known as the Placido de Mundo Elementary school. However the barangay is one of the barangays in the 6th District of Quezon City that has no public high school. Thus, graduates of Placido de Mundo Elementary School have to continue their education in a high school located different barangays.


To provide the residents of Barangay Talipapa with accessible secondary education, this bill seeks to establish a new national high school to be known as the Talipapa National High School.

## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY TALIPAPA, QUEZON CITY, METRO MANILA TO BE KNOWN AS TALIPAPA NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 Section 1. There is hereby established, under the supervision of the 2 Department of Education, a high school in Barangay Talipapa, Quezon City, Metro Manila to be known as Talipapa National High School. 3 4 Sec. 2. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the 5 Department's program the operationalization of the Talipapa National High School, 6 the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. 7 8 Sec. 3. The Secretary of Education shall issue rules and regulations 9 necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act. 10 11 12 Sec. 4. All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations, or other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or 13 modified accordingly. 14 15 **Sec. 5.** If any portion or provision of this act is declared unconstitutional, the 16 remainder of this Act or any provision not affected thereby shall remain in force and 17 effect. 18 19 20 Sec. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation. 21
