#### AN ACT

## PRESCRIBING A FIXED TERM OF OFFICE FOR THE CHIEF OF STAFF AND THE MAJOR SERVICE COMMANDERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES (AFP) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Declaration of Policy. – It is hereby declared the policy of the
 State to give due recognition to the significance of the positions of the Chief of
 Staff and the Major Service Commanders of the Armed Forces of the Philippines
 (AFP).

5 Section 2. *Terms of Office.* - The Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces of the 6 Philippines shall have a fixed term of office of three (3) years. The Major Service 7 Commanders shall each have a fixed term of office of two (2) years without 8 prejudice to being appointed as Chief of Staff if otherwise qualified.

9 The terms shall commence on the date of appointment by the President. 10 No extension of term shall be allowed, except for the position of Chief of Staff, 11 which may be extended in cases of war or national emergencies as declared by 12 Congress.

The President shall select from among the officers in the grades of Major General/Rear Admiral to Lieutenant General/Vice Admiral the officer who, in his or her opinion, is best qualified for the position of Chief of Staff; *Provided*, That the officer appointed as Chief of Staff of the AFP shall remain in office unless sooner removed for cause by the President; and, *Provided further*, That no officer shall be appointed as Chief of Staff if said officer has less than one (1) year of service remaining in the active service.

20 When the officer so appointed under this Section reaches the compulsory 21 retirement age before the end of his term, he shall be allowed to complete his 22 term but shall be deemed compulsorily retired upon completion of the same. Section 3. *Rules and Regulations.* – The Department of National Defense
 shall formulate the rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions
 of this Act.

Section 4. *Repealing Clause.* – Section 4 of R. A. No. 8186, with respect
to the maximum tenure in the position of Major Service Commanders, is hereby
amended accordingly.

All other issuances, laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations, or parts
 thereof not consistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

9 Section 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days 10 following its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of 11 general circulation.
