RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE, TO CONDUCT AN
 INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND
 REGULATIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11053, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS
 THE ANTI-HAZING ACT OF 2018, TO PROVIDE A CLEAR, CONSISTENT
 AND ACCURATE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS TO FULFILL
 THE MANDATE ENSHRINED IN THE ANTI-HAZING ACT OF 2018

8 **WHEREAS,** Article VI of the 1987 Constitution provides that the legislative 9 power shall be vested in the Congress of the Philippines which shall consist of a 10 Senate and a House of Representatives, except to the extent reserved to the 11 people by the provision on initiate and referendum;

WHEREAS, the Congress of the Philippines passed the Anti-Hazing Act of
2018 and was signed into law on June 29, 2018 and the Implementing Rules
and Regulations were finalized only last March 6, 2020.

15 WHEREAS, this representation has monitored the development in the 16 crafting of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Anti-Hazing Act 17 of 2018 by the Commission on Higher Education and clarified the legislative 18 intent of certain provisions of the law;

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WHEREAS, several members of the House of Representatives and the

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Senate also issued certifications to relay and inform the Chairperson of the
 technical working group of the legislative intent of some of the provisions of the

3 law;

WHEREAS, despite all these efforts from the lawmakers, the IRR of the
Anti-Hazing Act of 2018 failed to clarify and provide a clear guideline in the
implementation of the law based on the law's true intent;

7 WHEREAS, last September 14, 2020, Senator Francis Tolentino raised in
8 his privileged speech the alarming number of cases where the IRRs adopted by
9 the executive departments are inconsistent with or go beyond the laws enacted
10 by Congress;

WHEREAS, for failure to provide a clear and accurate implementing rules
that truly reflects the intention of the law, it is but proper to call for the review
of the IRR of the Anti-Hazing Act of 2018;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Senate of the Philippines, to call for the review of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Anti-Hazing Act of 2018 to be able to provide a clear, consistent and accurate implementing rules that truly reflects the law and its intent.
