AN ACT

MAKING THE POSITION OF A COOPERATIVES DEVELOPMENT OFFICER MANDATORY IN THE MUNICIPAL, CITY AND PROVINCIAL LEVELS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, AS AMENDED"

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 443, Book III, Title Two, Chapter 2 of Republic Act No. 7160 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 443. Officials of the Municipal Government. - (a) There shall be in each municipality a municipal mayor, a municipal vice-mayor, sangguniang bayan members, a secretary to the sangguniang bayan, a municipal treasurer, a municipal assessor, a municipal accountant, a municipal budget officer, a municipal planning and development coordinator, a municipal engineer/building official, a municipal health officer, a municipal civil registrar, AND A MUNICIPAL COOPERATIVES DEVELOPMENT OFFICER (CDO); PROVIDED, THAT THE MUNICIPALITY HAS THE OPTION TO APPOINT A FULL FLEDGED CDO OR MERGE SUCH POSITION TO AN EXISTING POSITION OR OFFICIAL IN A RELATED MUNICIPAL OFFICE, UNIT OR DEPARTMENT; PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT IF THE MUNICIPALITY SHALL APPOINT A FULL FLEDGED CDO, THE MUNICIPALITY HAS THE OPTION TO SET THE RANK,

REMUNERATION AND OTHER EMOLUMENTS OF THE MUNICIPAL 1 CDO SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS. 2 3 4 (b) x x x 5 $(c) \times \times \times$ $(d) \times \times \times$ 6 7 (e) x x x." SEC. 2. Section 454, Book III, Title Three, Chapter 2 of Republic Act No. 8 9 7160, is hereby amended to read as follows: 10 "SECTION 454. Officials of the City Government. - (a) There shall be 11 12 in each city a mayor, a vice-mayor, sangguniang panlungsod members, a secretary to the sangguniang panlungsod, a city treasurer, a city assessor, a 13 city accountant, a city budget officer, a city planning and development 14 coordinator, a city engineer, a city health officer, a city civil registrar, a city 15 administrator, a city legal officer, a city veterinarian, a city social welfare and 16 development officer, [and] a city general services officer, AND A CITY 17 COOPERATIVES DEVELOPMENT OFFICER (CDO); PROVIDED, THAT 18 19 THE CITY HAS THE OPTION TO APPOINT A FULL FLEDGED CDO OR MERGE SUCH POSITION TO AN EXISTING POSITION OR OFFICIAL 20 IN A RELATED CITY OFFICE, UNIT OR DEPARTMENT; PROVIDED, 21 FURTHER, THAT IF THE CITY SHALL APPOINT A FULL FLEDGED 22 **SET** THE CITY HAS THE **OPTION** TO THE 23 REMUNERATION AND OTHER EMOLUMENTS OF THE CITY CDO 24 SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS. 25

(b) In addition thereto, the city mayor may appoint a city architect, a city information officer, a city agriculturist, a city population officer, **AND A** city environment and natural resources officer [, and a city cooperatives officer].

SEC. 3. Section 463, Book III, Title Four, Chapter 2 of Republic Act No. 7160, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 463. Officials of the Provincial Government. - (a) There shall be in each province a governor, a vice-governor, members of the sangguniang panlalawigan, a secretary to the sangguniang panlalawigan, a provincial treasurer, a provincial assessor, a provincial accountant, a provincial engineer, a provincial budget officer, a provincial planning and development coordinator, a provincial legal officer, a provincial administrator, a provincial health officer, a provincial social welfare and development officer, a provincial general services officer, a provincial agriculturist, [and] a **PROVINCIAL** provincial veterinarian, **AND** Α **COOPERATIVES** DEVELOPMENT OFFICER (CDO); PROVIDED, THAT THE PROVINCE HAS THE OPTION TO APPOINT A FULL FLEDGED CDO OR MERGE SUCH POSITION TO AN EXISTING POSITION OR OFFICIAL IN A RELATED PROVINCIAL OFFICE, UNIT OR DEPARTMENT; PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT IF THE PROVINCE SHALL APPOINT A FULL FLEDGED CDO, THE PROVINCE HAS THE OPTION TO SET THE RANK, REMUNERATION AND OTHER EMOLUMENTS OF THE PROVINCIAL CDO SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

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(b) In addition thereto, the governor may appoint a provincial population officer, a provincial natural resources and environment officer, [a provincial cooperative officer,] a provincial architect, and a provincial information officer.

SEC. 4. Section 487, of Book III, Title Five, Article Seventeen of RA 7160, is hereby amended and shall now read as follows:

"Article Seventeen. - The Cooperatives **DEVELOPMENT** Officer

SECTION 487. Qualifications, Powers and Duties. - (a) No person shall be appointed cooperatives **DEVELOPMENT** officer unless one is a citizen of the Philippines, a resident of the local government unit concerned, of good moral character, a holder of a college degree preferably in **COOPERATIVES**, business administration with special training in cooperatives or any related course from a recognized college or university, and a first grade civil service eligible or its equivalent. He must have experience in cooperatives organizations and management of at least five (5) years in the case of provincial or city cooperatives

DEVELOPMENT officer, and three (3) years in the case of municipal cooperatives **DEVELOPMENT** officer.

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The appointment of the cooperatives **DEVELOPMENT** officer is [optional] **MANDATORY** for the municipal, city and provincial governments **AS SPECIFIED UNDER SECTIONS 443, 454 AND 463 OF THIS CODE.**

- (b) The cooperatives **DEVELOPMENT** officer shall take charge of the office for the development of cooperatives and shall:
- (1) Formulate measures for the consideration of the sanggunian, and provide technical assistance and support to the governor or mayor, as the case may be, in carrying out measures to ensure the delivery of basic services and provision of facilities through the **ORGANIZING, PROMOTION AND** development of cooperatives, and in providing access to such services and facilities;
- (2) Develop plans and strategies **IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COOPERATIVE SECTOR** and, upon approval thereof by the governor or mayor, as the case may be, implement the same, particularly those which have to do with the integration of cooperatives **VALUES**, principles and [methods] **PRACTICES** in programs and projects which the governor or mayor is empowered to implement and which the sanggunian is empowered to provide for under this Code;
- 19 (3) In addition to the foregoing duties and functions, the cooperatives 20 officer shall:
 - (i) [Assist in the organization of cooperatives] TAKE THE LEAD IN IDENTIFYING GROUPS, SECTORS OR COMMUNITIES THAT CAN BE ORGANIZED INTO COOPERATIVES WITH THE OBJECTIVE THAT THE COOPERATIVES TO BE ORGANIZED SHALL BE VEHICLES IN POVERTY REDUCTION, JOB CREATION, AND SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE MUNICIPALITY, CITY OR PROVINCE;
 - (ii) IN COLLABORATION WITH THE COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO PROSPECTIVE COOPERATIVES IN THE CONDUCT OF THE REQUIRED PRE-REGISTRATION SEMINAR AND/OR PRE-MEMBERSHIP EDUCATION SEMINAR AND IN THE PREPARATION OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION;
 - [(ii)] (iii) IN **PARTNERSHIP** WITH THE **COOPERATIVE** DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY, **GOVERNMENT** AGENCIES, **COOPERATIVE** UNIONS FEDERATIONS, THE ACADEME, AND OTHER PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS [P]provide technical and other forms of assistance to [existing] **DULY REGISTERED** cooperatives to enhance their viability as an economic enterprise and social organization INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO TRAINING AND EDUCATION, **BUSINESS MANAGEMENT,** FINANCE AND FINANCIAL **MANAGEMENT**;

- [(iii)] (iv) Assist cooperatives in establishing linkages with government agencies, COOPERATIVE UNIONS AND FEDERATIONS, THE ACADEME and non-government organizations involved in the promotion and integration of the concept of cooperatives in the livelihood of the people and other community activities;
- (4) [Be in the frontline of cooperatives organization, rehabilitation or viability-enhancement, particularly during and in the aftermath of] **ASSIST COOPERATIVES IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF RISK MANAGEMENT PLANS AND BUSINESS CONTINUITY PLANS AND MANAGEMENT AS A RESPONSE TO ANTICIPATED OR UNEXPECTED manmade and natural calamities and disasters, to aid in their survival and, if necessary subsequent rehabilitation;**

 - **SEC. 5.** Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations, issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.
 - **SEC. 6.** Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
