

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Infrastructures boost economic growth and development as well as improve the quality of lives of the people. This bill seeks to construct a coastal road that will connect Caloocan, Malabon, Navotas and Valenzuela area or the CAMANAVA, to the provinces of Bulacan, Pampanga, Bataan, which shall be known as the "BulPamBa National Coastal Road".

Through such construction, it aims to provide direct and convenient access route, facilitate movement of goods and services, ease the flow of traffic, and promote eco-tourism. All of these are for the economic growth and development of our country.

In view of the foregoing, early passage of this bill is earnestly requested.

MANDATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COASTAL ROAD CONNECTING THE CALOOCAN, MALABON, NAVOTAS, AND VALENZUELA AREA (CAMANAVA) TO THE PROVINCES OF BULACAN, PAMPANGA AND BATAAN, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. There shall be constructed a coastal road that will connect Caloocan,
Malabon, Navotas and Valenzuela area or the CAMANAVA, to the provinces of Bulacan,
Pampanga, Bataan to be known as the "BulPamBa National Coastal Road."

Sec. 2. The amount necessary to defray the cost of undertaking and completing the feasibility study and detailed engineering for this project and other activities related thereto shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act (GAA). Thereafter, the Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways, shall include in the Department's program the construction of said road, the funding of which shall be included in the annual GAA.

12 Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the 13 Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
