
EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert the Sindalan-Anao Provincial Road, connecting the town of Mexico and the City of San Fernando in the Province of Pampanga, into a National Road under the supervision of the Department of Public Works and Highways.

This conversion will be advantageous to the province not only because it will be included in the budget of the National Government which implies that the National Government may undertake the necessary repair, rehabilitation and upgrading of Infrastructure, but also because it will connect the different barangays in the province which results to economic growth and development in the locality.

In view of the foregoing, early passage of this bill is earnestly requested.

AN ACT CONVERTING THE SINDALAN-ANAO PROVINCIAL ROAD CONNECTING THE TOWN OF MEXICO TO THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO IN THE PROVINCE OF PAMPANGA INTO A NATIONAL ROAD, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines In Congress assembled:

Section 1. The Sindalan-Anao Provincial Road which connects the town of 1 Mexico and the City of San Fernando in the Province of Pampanga is hereby converted 2 into a national road under the supervision of the Department of Public Works and 3 Highways. 5 Sec. 2. The amounts needed to cover the improvement, maintenance and 6 7 repair of the said road shall be included in the General Appropriations Act. 8 9 Sec. 3. The Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the necessary orders, rules, and circulars to implement this Act. 10 11 Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication 12 in a newspaper of general circulation. 13
