

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY GREATER FAIRVIEW, QUEZON CITY, METRO MANILA, TO BE KNOWN AS WEST FAIRVIEW NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

EXPLANATORY NOTE


Article II, Section 17 of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall give priority to education. The Constitution further declares that the State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all.

The rapid growth of population in Barangay Greater Fairview, Quezon City requires the establishment of a new high school. The high schools in Muntinlupa have reported that it has been receiving increasing amount of enrollees the past few years. Providing accessible and quality education to its students with limited facilities and resources has been a constant challenge for the schools in the city.

To provide the residents of Barangay Greater Fairview with accessible secondary education, this bill seeks to establish a new national high school to be known as the West Fairview National High School.

In view of the foregoing, this representation earnestly seeks your support for the approval of this bill.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY GREATER FAIRVIEW, QUEZON CITY, METRO MANILA, TO BE KNOWN AS WEST FAIRVIEW NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, a national high school in Barangay Greater Fairview, Quezon City, Metro Manila, to be known as "West Fairview National High School".

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Education shall immediately include in the agency's program the operationalization of the West Fairview National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. The Secretary of the Education shall issue rules and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
