AN ACT

EXTENDING AND ENHANCING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LIFELINE RATE, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 73 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9136, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ELECTRIC POWER INDUSTRY REFORM ACT OF 2001, AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10150

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Extension of Lifeline Rate. - Section 73 of Republic Act No. 9136, 1 otherwise known as the Electric Power Industry Reform Act of 2001, as amended by 2 Republic Act No. 10150, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 3 4 "SEC. 73. Lifeline Rate. - A socialized pricing mechanism called a lifeline 5 rate for [the] QUALIFIED marginalized end-users shall be set by the 6 ERC which shall be exempted from the cross subsidy phase-out under 7 this Act for a period of [twenty (20)] THIRTY (30) years, unless 8 otherwise extended by law. The level of consumption and rate shall be 9 determined by the ERC after due notice and hearing: **PROVIDED**, 10 THAT THE ERC SHALL UTILIZE DATA FROM THE PHILIPPINE 11

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STATISTICS AUTHORITY (PSA) IN THE DERMINATION OF THE
 LEVEL OF CONSUMPTION.

3 QUALIFIED MARGINALIZED END-USERS SHALL REFER TO ANY
 4 OF THE FOLLOWING:

- **(A)** QUALIFIED HOUSEHOLD-BENEFICIARIES UNDER 5 **REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11310, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE** 6 PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM, 7 AS **REGULARLY SUBMITTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF** 8 SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) TO THE 9 DOE, THE ERC, AND THE DISTRIBUTION UTILITY; OR 10
- MARGINALIZED END-USERS WHO HAVE BEEN CERTIFIED **(B)** 11 AS SUCH BY THEIR DISTRIBUTION UTILITY BASED ON A 12 CRITERIA DETERMINED BY ERC: PROVIDED, THAT THE 13 CRITERIA SHALL TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE POVERTY 14 THRESHOLD SET BY THE PSA, AND SHALL CONTAIN AN 15 **EXCLUSIVE LIST OF REQUIREMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED** 16 TO THE DISTRIBUTION UTILITY: PROVIDED FURTHER, 17 THAT THE EXCLUSIVE LIST OF REQUIREMENTS SHALL 18 NOT BE BURDENSOME FOR THE APPLICANT: PROVIDED 19 FINALLY, THAT THE DISTRIBUTION UTILITY SHALL ACT 20 THE APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION ON AS 21 **MARGINALIZED END-USER WITHIN TWO (2) WORKING** 22 DAYS FROM SUBMISSION OF COMPLETE DOCUMENTARY 23 **REOUIREMENTS.** 24
- THE ERC SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR
 QUALIFIED MARGINALIZED END-USERS WHOSE METERS ARE
 NOT REGISTERED IN THEIR NAME.

28THE ERC SHALL SUBMIT TO THE JOINT CONGRESSIONAL29ENERGY COMMISSION AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE30IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LIFELINE RATE, AND A31COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION OF ITS IMPLEMENTATION

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EVERY THREE (3) YEARS TO INCLUDE A COST-BENEFIT
 ANALYSIS AS WELL AS MODES OF VALIDATION AND
 PREVENTION OF LEAKAGES."

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5 **SECTION 2. Implementing Rules and Regulations.** The ERC, together with the 6 DOE and DSWD, in consultation with the PSA and other public and private 7 stakeholders, shall promulgate the implementing rules and regulations of this Act 8 within ninety (90) calendar days from its effectivity.

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SECTION 3. Separability Clause. -If, for any reason, any provision of this Act or any part thereof shall be held unconstitutional and invalid, the other parts or provisions of this Act, which are not affected thereby, shall remain in full force and effect.

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SECTION 4. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, orders, rules, and regulations
 or parts thereof inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed,
 amended, or modified accordingly.

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SECTION 5. Effectivity Clause. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
 its publication in the Official Gazette or one (1) newspaper of general circulation.
