AN ACT FURTHER EXPANDING THE JURISDICTION OF METROPOLITAN TRIAL THECOURTS. MUNICIPAL TRIAL COURTS IN CITIES. MUNICIPAL TRIAL COURTS, AND MUNICIPAL CIRCUIT TRIAL COURTS, AMENDING FOR THE **PURPOSE** BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. **OTHERWISE** KNOWN AS THE "JUDICIARY REORGANIZATION ACT OF 1980", AS AMENDED

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 Section 1. Section 19 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 129,
- 2 otherwise known as the "Judiciary Reorganization Act of
- 3 1980", as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 19. Jurisdiction of the Regional
- 5 Trial Courts in Civil Cases. Regional Trial

Courts shall exercise exclusive original jurisdiction:

"(2) In all civil actions which involve the title to, or possession of, real property, or any interest therein, where the assessed value [of the property involved exceeds [Twenty thousand pesos (P20,000.00) or for civil actions in Metro Manila, where such value exceeds Fifty thousand pesos (P50,000.00) HUNDRED THOUSAND **PESOS** (P400,000.00), except for forcible entry into and unlawful detainer of lands or buildings, original jurisdiction over which is conferred upon the Metropolitan Trial Courts, and Municipal Trial Courts in Cities, Municipal Trial Courts, and Municipal Circuit Trial Courts;

"(3) In all actions in admiralty and maritime jurisdiction where the demand or

claims exceeds [One hundred thousand pesos

(P100,000.00) or, in Metro Manila, where such

demand or claim exceeds Two hundred

thousand pesos (P200,000.00)] TWO MILLION

PESOS (P2,000,000.00);

"(4) In all matters of probate, both testate and intestate, where the gross value of the estate exceeds [One hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00) or, in probate matters in Metro Manila where such gross value exceeds Two Hundred thousand pesos (P200,000.00)] TWO MILLION PESOS (P2,000,000.00);

"(8) In all other cases in which the demand, exclusive of interest, damages of whatever kind, attorney's fees, litigation expenses and costs or the value of the property in controversy exceeds [One hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00) or, in such other cases in Metro Manila, where the demand exclusive of the

1	abovementioned items exceeds Two Hundred
2	thousand pesos (P200,000.00)] TWO MILLION
3	PESOS (P2,000,000.00)."
4	SEC. 2. Section 33 of the same law is hereby amended
5	to read as follows:
6	"Section 33. Jurisdiction of the
7	Metropolitan Trial Courts, Municipal Trial
8	Courts in Cities, Municipal Trial Courts, and
9	Municipal Circuit Trial Courts in Civil Cases. –
10	Metropolitan Trial Courts, Municipal Trial
11	Courts in Cities, Municipal Trial Courts, and
12	Municipal Circuit Trial Courts shall exercise:
13	(1) Exclusive original jurisdiction over
14	civil actions and probate proceedings, testate
15	and intestate, including the grant of
16	provisional remedies in proper cases, where the
17	value of the personal property, estate, or
18	amount of the demand does not exceed [One
19	hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00), or in
20	Metro Manila where such personal property,

estate, or amount of the demand does not exceed Two hundred thousand pesos (P200,000.00)] **MILLION** TWO PESOS (P2,000,000.00), exclusive of interest, damages of whatever kind, attorney's fees, litigation expenses, and costs, the amount of which must be specifically alleged: Provided, That interest, damages of whatever kind, attorney's fees, litigation expenses, and costs shall be included in the determination of the filing fees: Provided, further, That where there are several claims or causes of actions between the same or different parties, embodied in the same complaint, the amount of the demand shall be the totality of the claims in all the causes of action, irrespective of whether the causes of action arose out of the same or different transactions:

"(3) Exclusive original jurisdiction in all civil actions which involve title to, or possession

2	the assessed value of the property or any
3	interest therein does not exceed [Twenty
4	thousand pesos (P20,000.00) or, in civil actions in
5	Metro Manila, where such assessed value does
6	not exceed Fifty thousand pesos (P50,000.00)]
7	FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS
8	(P400,000.00) exclusive on interest, damages of
9	whatever kind, attorney's fees, litigation
10	expenses and costs: Provided, That in cases of
11	land not declared for taxation purposes, the value
12	of such property shall be determined by the
13	assessed value of the adjacent lots.
14	"(4) EXCLUSIVE ORIGINAL JURISDICTION
15	IN ADMIRALTY AND MARITIME ACTIONS
16	WHERE THE DEMAND OR CLAIM DOES
17	NOT EXCEED TWO MILLION PESOS
18	(P2,000,000.00)."
19	Sec. 3. Delegated Authority of the Supreme Court to

Adjust the Jurisdictional Amounts for First and Second

- 1 Level Courts. The Supreme Court, unless otherwise
- 2 provided by law, without prejudice, however, on the part of
- 3 the Congress to adjust the amounts when the
- 4 circumstances so warrant, may adjust the jurisdictional
- 5 amount for first and second level courts to: (1) reflect the
- 6 extraordinary supervening inflation or deflation of
- 7 currency; (2) reflect change in the land valuation; or (3)
- 8 maintain the proportion of caseload between first and
- 9 second level courts.
- 10 SEC. 4. The provisions of this Act shall apply
- 11 prospectively to all civil cases filed in the second level
- 12 courts and first level courts from the date of its effectivity
- 13 thereof.
- 14 SEC. 5. Separability Clause. If any provision of this
- 15 Act is declared unconstitutional, the same shall not affect
- 16 the validity and effectivity of the other provisions thereof.
- 17 SEC. 6. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, and
- 18 orders inconsistent with the provisions of this Act shall be
- 19 considered amended or modified accordingly.

- 1 SEC. 7. Effectivity Clause. This Act shall take effect
- 2 fifteen (15) days following its publication in the Official
- 3 Gazette or in two (2) national newspapers of general
- 4 circulation.
