AN ACT SEPARATING THE TABUK CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL -

NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS BANTAY
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Tabuk City National High School - Bantay
2 Extension in Barangay Bantay, Tabuk City, Province of Kalinga is
3 hereby separated from the Tabuk City National High School and
4 converted into an independent national high school to be known as
5 Bantay National High School.

6 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the
7 Tabuk City National High School - Bantay Extension are hereby
8 transferred to and absorbed by the Bantay National High School.

9 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include
10 in the Department's program the operationalization of the Bantay
11 National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged

1 against the current year's appropriation of the Tabuk City National
2 High School - Bantay Extension. Thereafter, the amount necessary
3 for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the
4 annual General Appropriations Act.

5 SEC. 4. Within one hundred twenty (120) days after the
6 approval of this Act, the Secretary of Education shall formulate the
7 rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.

8 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
9 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
10 circulation.
