AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT AGRICULTURE TO USE THE ANNUAL TARIFF REVENUES IN EXCESS OF P10 BILLION, UNDER ACT 11203 "AN REPUBLIC NO. OR LIBERALIZING THE IMPORTATION. EXPORTATION AND TRADING OF RICE, LIFTING **QUANTITATIVE** PURPOSE FOR THE THE IMPORT RESTRICTION ONRICE, AND PURPOSES", FOR DIRECT OTHER CASH ASSISTANCE TO FARMERS OWNING ONE (1) HECTARE OR LESS OF RICE LAND UNTIL 2024

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 Section 1. Title. This Act shall be known as the
- 2 "Cash Assistance for Filipino Farmers Act of 2020".
- 3 Sec. 2. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby the
- 4 declared policy of the State to address the plight of small

- 1 farmers in the country. The State recognizes the urgency of
- 2 intervening for our farmers in light of the current state of
- 3 declining palay prices and the crippling effects of the
- 4 COVID pandemic. Towards this end, the State shall
- 5 provide monetary assistance to the hardest hit segments of
- 6 our small farmers in the form of actual giving of cash to
- 7 farmers.
- 8 SEC. 3. Coverage. This Act shall apply only to
- 9 farmers owning one (1) hectare or less of rice land. The
- 10 Department of Agriculture (DA) shall establish actual
- beneficiaries of this Act on the basis of its Registry System
- 12 for Basic Sectors in Agriculture (RSBSA) for rice.
- 13 SEC. 4. Authorization. The DA is hereby authorized
- 14 to use the monies from the annual tariff revenues in excess
- 15 of Ten billion pesos (P10B), as provided in Section 13 of
- 16 Republic Act No. 11203, for direct provision of cash
- 17 assistance to farmers. The Bureau of Customs (BOC) is
- 18 hereby mandated to directly remit to the DA the said
- 19 excess funds.

- 1 Further, any money in excess of Ten billion pesos
- 2 (P10B) in the annual tariff revenues in any given year in
- 3 the life of the Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund
- 4 (RCEF) under said Act, shall automatically be given as
- 5 cash assistance to farmers, unless otherwise amended by
- 6 law.
- 7 The BOC and the DA shall submit separate reports to
- 8 Congress at year end, through the Committee or
- 9 Agriculture, on the remittance of funds and the actual fund
- 10 disbursement for the year, respectively.
- 11 SEC. 5. *Funding*. The source of funds for the annual
- 12 direct cash assistance to farmers shall be the excess of Ten
- 13 billion pesos (P10B) in the annual revenue collections
- 14 under Republic Act No. 11203.
- 15 SEC. 6. Separability Clause. In case any provision or
- 16 any part thereof is declared unconstitutional, the other
- 17 provisions not so declared and affected shall remain in
- 18 force and effect.
- 19 SEC. 7. Repealing Clause. Any law, presidential
- 20 decree or issuance, executive order, letter of instruction,

- 1 rule or regulation inconsistent or contrary to the provisions
- 2 of this Act is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- 3 SEC. 8. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect
- 4 immediately following its publication in the Official
- 5 *Gazette* or in any newspaper of general circulation.
