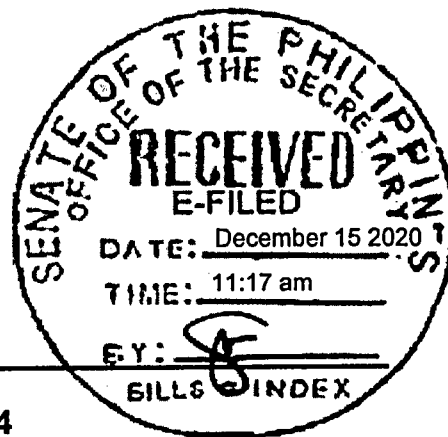

MUNICIPALITY OF PIODURAN, PROVINCE OF ALBAY"**


have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved without amendment.





AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
LA MEDALLA IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PIODURAN,
PROVINCE OF ALBAY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay La Medalla.* – The Sitio of
2 La Medalla is hereby separated from Barangay Caratagan in the
3 Municipality of Pioduran, Province of Albay, and constituted into a
4 distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay La
5 Medalla.

6 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries
7 of Barangay La Medalla are hereby described as follows:

8 “Bounded by the following barangays of the Municipality of
9 Pioduran: on the North by Barangay Flores; on the Northeast by
10 Barangay Binodegahan; on the Southeast by Barangay Caratagan;
11 on the Southwest by Barangay Banawan; on the West by Barangay
12 Marigondon; and on the Northwest by Barangay Panganiran.

9 *SEC. 3. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The
10 plebiscite conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections
11 (COMELEC) in Barangay La Medalla, pursuant to Provincial
12 Ordinance No. 09-93 dated July 1, 1993 and approved on August 9,
13 1993 by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Albay,
14 which ratified the creation of Barangay La Medalla as proclaimed
15 by the Provincial Board of Canvassers on November 21, 1993, shall
16 serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement
17 under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise
18 known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

19 *SEC. 4. Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent
20 barangay officials of Barangay La Medalla shall continue to hold
21 office until such time that their successors have been duly elected
22 and qualified.

23 *SEC. 5. Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
24 infrastructure and facilities existing therein at the time of the
25 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or
26 compensation to and shall be administered by the new barangay.

1 SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay La
2 Medalla shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA)
3 shares pursuant to Section 285 of the Local Government Code of
4 1991, as amended.

5 SEC. 7. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
6 days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of
7 general circulation.
