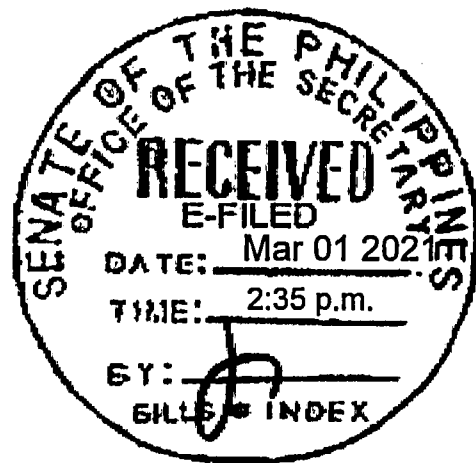

RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING THE PROFOUND SYMPATHY AND SINCERE CONDOLENCES OF THE SENATE ON THE DEATH OF FORMER CAVITE GOVERNOR ERINEO "AYONG" MALIKSI

1 WHEREAS, Former Cavite Governor and former Philippine Charity
2 Sweepstakes Office (PCSO) Chairperson Erineo "Ayong" Maliksi passed away last 24
3 February 2021 at the age of 82;

4 WHEREAS, Maliksi had been in public office for nearly forty (40) years starting
5 in 1980 when he became the Vice Mayor of Imus in the Province of Cavite before
6 coming the City's Mayor from 1988 to 1998;

7 WHEREAS, after his mayoralty stint, he represented the 2nd District of Cavite
8 at the House of Representatives from 1998 to 2001;

9 WHEREAS, from 2001 to 2010, Maliksi served as the Governor of the Province
10 of Cavite completing his three terms in office. He then returned to the House of
11 Representatives in 2010 until 2013;

12 WHEREAS, after serving elected posts, he was appointed as Chairperson of
13 the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office (PCSO) in 2015 where he served until
14 2016;

15 WHEREAS, Ayong Maliksi was deeply-loved and respected in the Province of
16 Cavite, and the nation, in general. He was a true public servant, a leader, and a true
17 embodiment of a Caviteño – brave, compassionate, and resolute. The country will
18 sincerely mourn his demise: Now, Therefore be it
