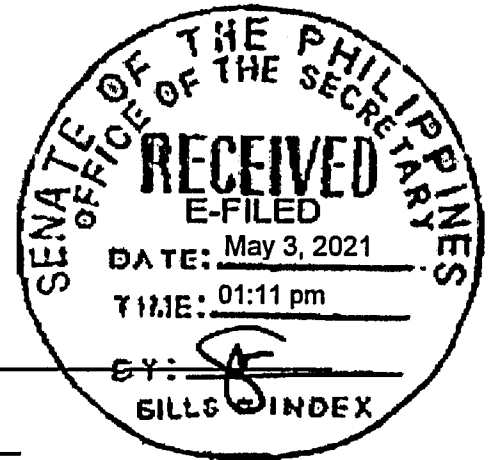


have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 8132 be approved without amendment.

AN ACT
CONVERTING THE SISIGON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN BARANGAY
SISIGON, MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOC, PROVINCE OF SORSOGON INTO AN
INTEGRATED SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS SISIGON INTEGRATED SCHOOL,
AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The Sisigon Elementary School in Barangay Sisigon, Municipality of
2 Matnog, Province of Sorsogon is hereby converted into an integrated school to be known as
3 Sisigon Integrated School.

4
5 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Sisigon Elementary
6 School are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Sisigon Integrated School.

7
8 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's
9 program the operationalization of the Sisigon Integrated School, the funding of which shall
10 be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

11
12 SEC. 4. Within ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act, the Secretary of
13 Education shall issue the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.

14
15 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
16 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.

18 *Approved,*
