## RESOLUTION

COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING NONITO DONAIRE, JR. FOR WINNING THE WORLD BOXING COUNCIL (WBC) BANTAMWEIGHT CHAMPIONSHIP HELD LAST MAY 29, 2021 IN CARSON, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Nonito "The Filipino Flash" Donaire, Jr. triumphed over French boxer Nordine Oubaali and secured the World Boxing Council (WBC) Bantamweight Championship title in a bout held last 29 May 2021 at Dignity Health Sports Park stadium in Carson, California;

WHEREAS, the 38-year-old Donaire, coming with a professional boxing record of 40 wins with 26 knockouts and 6 losses, dominated the fight from the onset, as he knocked down his opponent twice in the third round, and again in the fourth round which prompted the referee to stop the match;

WHEREAS, Donaire's victory not only brought the first career loss for his erstwhile undefeated foe, but also made history to become the oldest bantamweight champion in boxing;

WHEREAS, Donaire, the four-division world boxing champion, World Boxing Hall of Fame "Most Outstanding Boxer of the Year" in 2007, and "Fighter of the Year" in 2012, once again demonstrated his distinctive speed, exceptional power and sportsmanship in his first fight since November 2019;

WHEREAS, his ultimate goal of becoming an undisputed bantamweight champion and his positive mindset of continuous learning and training display his immense passion for the sport and serve as inspiration for other athletes and sportsmen and women;
