

### AN ACT AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 4566, AS AMENDED BY PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1746, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE CONTRACTORS' LICENSE LAW

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Section 23 of Republic Act No. 4566, as amended, is hereby
amended to read as follows:

"Section 23. Issuance of Licenses. Upon the payment of the 3 corresponding fee and the filing of the application, and after examination and 4 investigation as may be required, the Board within fifteen (15) days after the 5 approval of the application shall issue a license to the applicant permitting him 6 to engage in business as a contractor under the terms of this Act for [the 7 remaining-part-of-the-fiscal-year] ONE (1) YEAR FROM THE DATE OF 8 **ISSUANCE. APPLICATIONS SHALL BE ACTED UPON WITHIN THE** 9 PERIOD PROVIDED FOR UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11032 OR THE 10 EASE OF DOING BUSINESS AND EFFICIENT GOVERNMENT SERVICE 11 **DELIVERY ACT OF 2018."** 12

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Sec. 2. Section 35 of Republic Act No. 4566, as amended, is hereby deleted,
and replaced with a new Section 35, to read as follows:

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"*SECTION 35. PROHIBITED ACTS.* THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED UNDER THIS ACT:

(a) ANY CONTRACTOR WHO, FOR A PRICE, COMMISSION, 5 FEE OR WAGE, SUBMITS OR ATTEMPTS TO SUBMIT A BID TO 6 CONSTRUCT, OR CONTRACTS TO OR UNDERTAKES TO 7 CONSTRUCT, OR ASSUMES CHARGE IN A SUPERVISORY 8 CAPACITY OF A CONSTRUCTION WORK WITHIN THE PURVIEW 9 OF THIS ACT, WITHOUT FIRST SECURING A LICENSE TO 10 ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF CONTRACTING IN THE 11 PHILIPPINES SHALL BE PENALIZED WITH A FINE OF NOT LESS 12 THAN ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) BUT 13 NOT MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS 14 (P500,000.00) AND THE EQUIVALENT OF ONE-TENTH OF ONE 15 PERCENT (0.1%) OF THE PROJECT COST. FURTHERMORE, THE 16 OFFENDING PARTY SHALL BE PROHIBITED FROM OBTAINING 17 A CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR 18 FROM THE TIME HE OR SHE IS FOUND GUILTY UNDER THIS 19 **PROVISION.** 20

THE SAME FINE MENTIONED IN THE IMMEDIATELY (b) 22 PRECEDING PROVISION SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON TWO OR 23 MORE LICENSEES, EACH OF WHOM HAS BEEN ISSUED A 24 LICENSE TO ENGAGE SEPARATELY IN THE CAPACITY OF A 25 CONTRACTOR BUT SHALL JOINTLY SUBMIT A BID OR 26 OTHERWISE ACT IN THE CAPACITY OF A CONTRACTOR 27 WITHOUT SECURING AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR ACTING 28 IN THE CAPACITY OF SUCH A JOINT VENTURE OR 29 COMBINATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF 30 THIS ACT. THE LICENSES OF THE OFFENDING PARTIES SHALL 31 BE AUTOMATICALLY REVOKED AND THEY SHALL BE 32

PROHIBITED FROM OBTAINING A CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FROM THE TIME THE LICENSEES ARE FOUND GUILTY UNDER THIS PROVISION.

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(c)IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON WHO IS A 5 MANAGING PARTNER, OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF A LICENSED 6 PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION, FIRM, ASSOCIATION OR 7 OTHER ORGANIZATION TO INDIVIDUALLY ENGAGE IN THE 8 CONSTRUCTING BUSINESS OR INDIVIDUALLY ACT IN THE CAPACITY OF A CONTRACTOR WITHIN THIS JURISDICTION WITHOUT HAVING A LICENSE IN GOOD STANDING TO SO 11 ENGAGE OR ACT. ANYONE FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF 12 THIS PROVISION SHALL BE PENALIZED WITH A FINE OF NOT 13 LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) 14 BUT NOT MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS 15 (P500,000.00). FURTHERMORE, THE OFFENDING PARTY SHALL 16 **BE PROHIBITED FROM OBTAINING A CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE** 17 FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FROM THE TIME HE OR SHE IS 18 FOUND GUILTY UNDER THIS PROVISION. 19

(d) ANY PERSON WHO SHALL PRESENT OR FILE THE LICENSE 21 CERTIFICATE OF ANOTHER, GIVE FALSE EVIDENCE OF ANY 22 KIND TO THE BOARD OR TO ANY MEMBER THEREOF IN 23 **OBTAINING A CERTIFICATE OR LICENSE, IMPERSONATE** 24 ANOTHER, OR USE AN EXPIRED OR REVOKED CERTIFICATE OR 25 LICENSE SHALL BE PENALIZED WITH A FINE OF NOT LESS 26 THAN FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P500,000.00) BUT 27 NOT MORE THAN ONE MILLION PESOS (P1,000,000.00) AND 28 THE PENALTY OF IMPRISONMENT OF NOT LESS THAN ONE (1) 29 YEAR BUT NOT MORE THAN SIX (6) YEARS. THE PENALTIES 30 **PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION ARE WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO** 31 ANY LIABILITY FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE 32

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1	PROVISIONS OF THE REVISED PENAL CODE, AS AMENDED, OR
2	OTHER SPECIAL LAWS."
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5	Sec. 3. Sections 37 and 38 of Republic Act No. 4566, as amended, are hereby
6	deleted.
7	Sec. 4. Section 39 of Republic Act No. 4566, as amended, is hereby amended
8	to read as follows:
9	"Section [39] 37. Fee. The amount of fees prescribed by this Act shall
10	be as follows:
11	(a) [Fifty] FIVE THOUSAND pesos for an original license;
12	(b) [Sixty] SIX THOUSAND pesos for examination of an applicant;
13	(c) [Fifty] FIVE THOUSAND pesos for annual renewal."
14	THE BOARD IS AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND UTILIZE
15	OR APPLY ALL FEES, FINES, AND OTHER CHARGES COLLECTED BY IT
16	UNDER THIS ACT TO AUGMENT ITS ACCREDITATION AND LICENSING
17	OPERATIONS, THE PROVISIONS OF ANY LAW TO THE CONTRARY
18	NOTWITHSTANDING. THE BOARD, IN CONSULTATION WITH ITS
19	STAKEHOLDERS, IS AUTHORIZED TO ADJUST THE FEES NOT MORE
20	THAN ONCE EVERY THREE (3) YEARS, BUT IN NO CASE SHALL THE FEES
21	BE ADJUSTED OR INCREASED BY MORE THAN FIFTEEN PERCENT
22	(15%)."
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24	Section 5. Section 40 of Republic Act No. 4566, as amended, is hereby amended
25	to read as follows:
26	"Section [40] 38. Renewal. A license [may-be-renewed-by-the-filing-of-a
27	renewal-application with the registrar not later than June thirtleth of each fiscal
28	year, accompanied by the annual-renewal-fee. A license renewed thereafter shall
29	be subject to an additional fee of Twenty-Pesos] ISSUED PURSUANT TO THE
30	PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL BE VALID FOR ONE (1) YEAR FROM
31	THE DATE OF ITS APPROVAL. A license renewed thereafter shall be subject to
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[an-additional] A RENEWAL fee of [<del>Twenty</del>] FIVE THOUSAND Pesos (P5,000.00) PURSUANT TO SECTION 37 OF THIS ACT.

IN CASE THE CONTRACTOR HAS BEEN IN OPERATION IN GOOD STANDING FOR TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS OR MORE, IT MAY RENEW ITS LICENSE EVERY THREE (3) YEARS. IF IT HAS BEEN IN OPERATION IN GOOD STANDING FOR TEN (10) YEARS BUT NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS, IT MAY RENEW ITS LICENSE EVERY TWO (2) YEARS. IF IT HAS BEEN IN OPERATION IN GOOD STANDING FOR LESS THAN TEN (10) YEARS, IT SHALL RENEW ITS LICENSE EVERY YEAR.

10APPLICATIONS AND ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSE11RENEWAL MAY BE FILED WITH THE BOARD OR ITS DESIGNATED12AGENCIES EITHER IN PERSON OR THROUGH ONLINE NOT EARLIER13THAN NINETY (90) DAYS BUT NOT LATER THAN THIRTY (30) DAYS14BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF THE LICENSE."

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Sec. 6. Section 41 of Republic Act No. 4566, as amended, and the following
sections, are hereby renumbered accordingly.

18 Sec. 7. Separability Clause. – Should any provision or part of this Act be 19 declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions and parts hereof not affected, 20 and insofar as they are separable from the invalid ones, shall remain in full force and 21 effect.

Sec. 8. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, decrees, orders, issuances rules and
regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed
or modified accordingly.

Sec. 9. *Effectivity*. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
publication in the *Official Gazette* or in at least two (2) newspapers of general
circulation.
