RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON LABOR, EMPLOYMENT AND **HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, AND OTHER APPROPRIATE SENATE** COMMITTEES, TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION IN AID OF LEGISLATION ON THE VACCINATION PROGRAM IMPLEMENTED ON OVERSEAS FILIPINO AND **ENSURE** THEIR **INCLUDING** SEAFARERS, WORKERS, **DEPLOYMENT ABROAD**

WHEREAS, during the hearing conducted by the Senate Committee on Labor, Employment and Human Resources Development on 10 May 2021, this Representation expressed his concerns on the reported policy of certain countries to require foreigners entering their territory to be vaccinated with specific brands of Coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccines;

WHEREAS, in the same hearing, an official from the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) said that the apprehension raised by this Representation was incorrect:

"SEN. TOLENTINO. With the permission of the Chair and my other colleagues, the creeping policy that I have heard is this: Before you enter another country, whether you are an OFW, a tourist or whatever classification, you should have a certain type of vaccine. For instance, Israel, I heard, and some European countries, will not accept those vaccinated with Chinese vaccines. Am I correct?

[LABOR OFFICIAL]. Your Honor, I don't think that is a correct information, Your Honor. In fact, we are meeting some of them anytime this

week, Your Honor, because they need not less than 5,000 of our caregivers. And, in fact, I had a meeting with an ambassador, nakikiusap siya na ipadala na namin sila.

SEN. TOLENTINO. I hope you are correct.

[LABOR OFFICIAL]. Yes, Your Honor.

SEN. TOLENTINO. Because we are after the right vaccines for our countrymen, not just OFW entering a country. I won't mention the other countries, I might be wrong. I hope I am wrong. Whether vaccinated or not, they should be allowed to enter. But, of course, the host country has the proper determination of the type of visas—not just visas, but those who will be allowed to enter their jurisdiction. So we have to be correct on this. x x x So can you clarify this for the sake of our countrymen who will be travelling within the next few months if they receive the country-specific vaccine or, if there is a country-specific vaccine? And you can check that with your DFA counterpart or your POLO or what have you, para lang maliwanag."

WHEREAS, on 1 May 2021, five thousand (5,000) minimum wage workers and overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) workers were inoculated with the Sinovac-CoronaVac COVID-19 (Sinovac) vaccine as part of the Labor Day celebration in Manila spearheaded by the DOLE;²

WHEREAS, Switzerland, along with other countries in the European Union, plans to exempt fully vaccinated foreign travelers from the required entry quarantine protocols. However, the exemption will apply only to those inoculated with vaccines made by Western pharmaceutical companies Pfizer, AstraZeneca, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson.³ Further, travelers from countries with significant concerns on Covid variants will still not be allowed entry despite receiving vaccination;⁴

WHEREAS, Saudi Arabia also eased travel restrictions for foreign travelers vaccinated with Pfizer, AstraZeneca, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson but excluded in the list those vaccinated with Chinese-made vaccines such as Sinovac and Sinopharm.⁵ DOLE, however, clarified that OFWs not vaccinated with the approved brands will still be allowed entry but will have to undergo the required RT-PCR test and the "institutional quarantine" upon arrival;⁶

WHEREAS, on 28 May 2021, Malacañang announced that outbound OFWs will be moved up to the top priority group for vaccination or the A1 category.7 President Duterte likewise approved the plea of Filipino seafarers to be inoculated with Westernmade COVID-19 vaccines as most international shipping companies only allow embarkation of crew members who were inoculated with Western vaccines;8

WHEREAS, on 1 June 2021, the World Health Organization (WHO) included the Sinovac vaccine in its Emergency Use Listing (EUL), whereby the quality, safety, and efficacy of COVID-19 vaccines are assessed. WHO's EUL is a prerequisite for COVAX Facility vaccine supply that would allow countries to expedite their own regulatory approval to import and administer COVID-19 vaccines;9

WHEREAS, the differing treatments implemented by host countries on the basis of the type of COVID-19 vaccine administered may entail additional costs at the expense of a deployed OFW. Since the Philippines is continuously deploying Filipino workers abroad amidst the pandemic, there is a need to craft policies that are aligned and consistent with those of the prospective host countries for the proper implementation of the COVID-19 vaccination program of OFWs, taking into consideration their health and safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, TO DIRECT THE SENATE HUMAN **RESOURCES** LABOR, EMPLOYMENT AND COMMITTEE ON DEVELOPMENT, AND OTHER APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEES, TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION IN AID OF LEGISLATION ON THE **FILIPINO OVERSEAS** PROGRAM IMPLEMENTED ON **VACCINATION THEIR** SAFE **ENSURE** INCLUDING SEAFARERS, AND WORKERS, **DEPLOYMENT ABROAD.**
