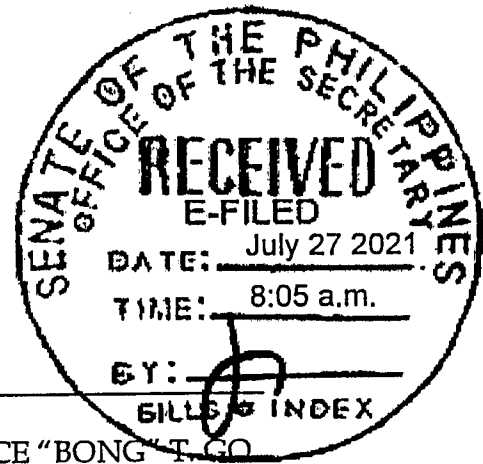

RESOLUTION
COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING HIDILYN DIAZ FOR
BAGGING THE GOLD MEDAL IN WEICHLIFTING AT THE 2020
TOKYO OLYMPICS

- 1 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine Senate, on several occasions has paid tribute to
2 outstanding Filipinos for their exemplary performance and remarkable
3 contribution in their respective fields raising the nation's pride;
- 4 **WHEREAS**, Hidilyn Diaz, pride of Zamboanga City, once again brought glory
5 and honor to the country by making history as she reigned supreme, capturing
6 the country's first-ever gold medal in the women's 55kg weightlifting
7 tournament of the 2020 Tokyo Olympics;
- 8 **WHEREAS**, the Filipina weightlifter, has put an end in the country's quest for
9 the elusive Olympic gold medal, edging out world champion Liao Qiuyun of
10 China and Kazakhstan's Zulfiya Chinshanlo;
- 11 **WHEREAS**, Diaz, finished with a total score of 224kg lifting 97kg in the snatch
12 and 127kg in the clean and jerk, outperforming Liao Qiuyun who scored 223kg
13 clinching on the 2nd spot, tying Diaz at 97kg in snatch and 127kg in the clean
14 and jerk, while Zulfiya Chinshanlo finishing 90kg in snatch and 123kg in clean
15 and jerk settling for bronze medal with a total of 213kg;
- 16 **WHEREAS**, the astounding performance, commitment and unrelenting spirit
17 of Filipino competitiveness and excellence shown by Hidilyn Diaz truly
18 deserves to be commended for the recognition and distinction she has brought
19 to the country;
- 20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by
21 the Senate, commending and congratulating Hidilyn Diaz for bagging the gold
22 medal in weightlifting at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics.
