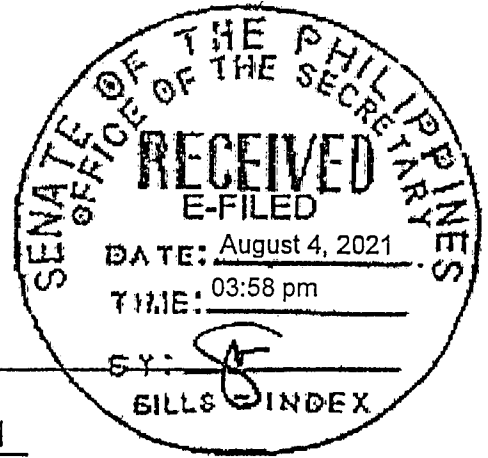


have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 8996 be approved without amendment.

**AN ACT
ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY LACARON,
MUNICIPALITY OF MALITA, PROVINCE OF DAVAO OCCIDENTAL, TO BE
KNOWN AS LACARON NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR**

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** There is hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of
2 Education, a national high school in Barangay Lacaron, Municipality of Malita, Province of
3 Davao Occidental, to be known as Lacaron National High School.
4

5 **SEC. 2.** The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's
6 program the operationalization of the Lacaron National High School, the funding of which
7 shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
8

9 **SEC. 3.** Within sixty days (60) days from the approval of this Act, the Secretary of
10 Education shall promulgate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.

12 **SEC. 4.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
13 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
