AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 27(B) OF THE NATIONAL INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1997, AS AMENDED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 Section 1. Section 27(B) of the National Internal
- 2 Revenue Code of 1997, as amended, is hereby further
- 3 amended to read as follows:

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- 4 "(B) [Proprietary Educational Institutions and
  - Hospitals. Proprietary educational institutions and

1	hospitals which are non-profit] HOSPITALS
2	WHICH ARE NON-PROFIT AND PROPRIETARY
3	EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS shall pay a tax of
4	ten percent (10%) on their taxable income except
5	those covered by Subsection (D) hereof: Provided,
6	That beginning July 1, 2020 until June 30, 2023, the
7	tax rate herein imposed shall be one percent (1%):
8	Provided further, That if the gross income from
9	unrelated trade, business or other activity exceeds
10	fifty percent (50%) of the total gross income derived
11	by such educational institutions or hospitals from all
12	sources, the tax prescribed in Subsection (A) hereof
13	shall be imposed on the entire taxable income. For
14	purposes of this Subsection, the term 'unrelated
15	trade, business or other activity' means any trade,
16	business or other activity, the conduct of which is
17	not substantially related to the exercise or
18	performance by such educational institution or
19	hospital of its primary purpose or function.
20	'Proprietary EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION' means

- 1 [a private hospital, or] any private school 2 maintained and administered by private individuals 3 or groups with an issued permit to operate from the 4 Department ofEducation (DepEd), the 5 Commission on Higher Education (CHED), or the 6 Technical Education and Skills Development 7 Authority (TESDA), as the case may be, in 8 accordance with existing laws and regulations."
- 9 SEC. 2. Implementing Rules and Regulations. The
  10 Department of Finance shall promulgate the necessary
  11 rules and regulations for the effective implementation of
  12 the provisions of this Act.
- SEC. 3. Separability Clause. If any portion or provision of this Act is subsequently declared invalid or unconstitutional, other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.
  - SEC. 4. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Act, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

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- 1 SEC. 5. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect
- 2 fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette
- 3 or in a newspaper of general circulation.
