

### EXPLANATORY NOTE


COVID-19 claimed many lives. Some frontliners were not even given the benefits they deserve. Now, more than ever, we need more frontline workers to help protect the populace.

# DECLARING THE LAST MONDAY OF AUGUST OF EVERY YEAR AS NATIONAL PANDEMIC FRONTLINERS' DAY TO SYNCHRONIZE WITH THE OBSERVANCE OF THE NATIONAL HEROES' DAY

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 Section 1. Short Title.. This Act shall be known as Pandemic Frontliners' Day.

3 Sec. 2. *Declaration of Policy*. – The State recognizes the vital role of pandemic frontliners in

4 the protection and promotion of the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness

5 among Filipinos.

Sec. 3. Observance of Pandemic Frontliners' Day. – To ensure the meaningful observance of the National Pandemic Frontliners' Day during the national heroes day, all national government agencies, local government units, including private, non-government organizations and civil service organizations, are encouraged to organize, participate and engage in ceremonies in their localities, communities, offices or establishments to honor our modern heroes battling the pandemic.

Sec. 4. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in
the Official Gazette or a newspaper of general circulation, whichever comes earlier.
