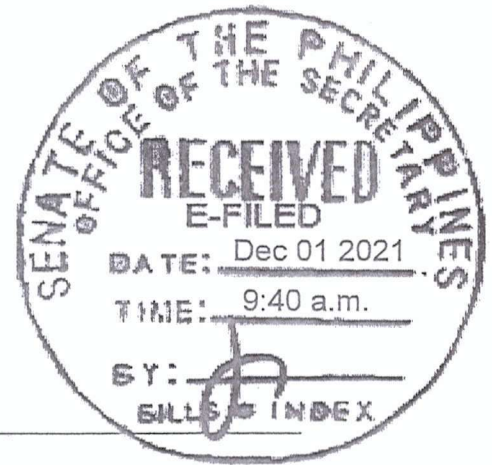

The Committees on Local Government, and Electoral Reforms and People's Participation, to which were referred **House Bill No. 4983**, introduced by Representative Joselito "Joel" S. Sacdalan, entitled:

"AN ACT

SEPARATING THE SITIO OF LOWER DADO FROM BARANGAY DADO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALAMADA, PROVINCE OF NORTH COTABATO AND CONSTITUTING IT INTO A DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY LOWER DADO"

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 4983 be approved with the following amendments:


1. On page 2, line 25 to page 3, line 2, delete entire Section 6, and replace with a new Section 6, to read thus:

"SEC. 6. NATIONAL TAX ALLOTMENT SHARES. — BARANGAY LOWER DADO SHALL BE ENTITLED TO AN ALLOTMENT DERIVED FROM NATIONAL TAXES PURSUANT TO SECTION 285 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, AS AMENDED."

2. Finally, to renumber the Sections accordingly, and subject to style.

BY REPRESENTATIVE SACDALAN, PER COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 66

AN ACT SEPARATING THE SITIO OF LOWER DADO FROM BARANGAY DADO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALAMADA, PROVINCE OF NORTH COTABATO AND CONSTITUTING IT INTO A DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY LOWER DADO

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Lower Dado.* – The sitio of
2 Lower Dado consisting of Puroks Mangga, Lanzones, Santol,
3 Durian, Pomelo, Sampalok, Rambutan, and Lakatan, is hereby
4 separated from Barangay Dado in the Municipality of Alamada,
5 Province of North Cotabato and constituted as a distinct and
6 independent barangay to be known as Barangay Lower Dado.

7 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries
8 of Barangay Lower Dado are hereby described as follows:

9 “Beginning at point marked Point 1 being the Southwestern
10 corner of Lot 1530, Pls-1013; thence following the Macabasa River
11 in a Northeasterly direction to the common corner of Lot Nos. 2 and
12 13, GSS 540, marked Point 2; thence following the Tukuman Creek

1 in a Northeasterly direction to the Northernmost corner of Lot No.
2 34; GSS 540, to the Northeastern sides of Lot No. 42 marked Point
3 4; thence Southward following the Libungan River to the Southeast
4 corner of Lot 1554, Pls-1013, marked Point 5; thence following the
5 Southeastern sides of Lot Nos. 1554, 1570, 1566, 1567, 443, 1053,
6 1526, 1529, and 1530 Pls-1013 the point of beginning.”

7 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The
8 plebiscite conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections
9 (COMELEC) pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 14, Series of
10 1991 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of North
11 Cotabato, which ratified the creation of Barangay Lower Dado as
12 proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on November 29,
13 2017, shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite
14 requirement under Section 10 of the Local Government Code of
15 1991, as amended.

16 SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent
17 elected barangay officials of Barangay Lower Dado shall continue to
18 hold office until such time that their successors have been duly
19 elected and qualified.

20 SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
21 infrastructure and facilities existing therein at the time of the
22 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or
23 compensation to and shall be administered by the new Barangay
24 Lower Dado.

25 SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay
26 Lower Dado shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA)

1 shares pursuant to Section 285 of the Local Government Code of
2 1991, as amended.

3 SEC. 7. *Effectivity.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
4 days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper
5 of general circulation.
