AN ACT

RENAMING BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LUPON, PROVINCE  
OF DAVAO ORIENTAL AS BARANGAY ERNESTO D. VIOLAN

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1.** Barangay San Isidro in the Municipality of Lupon, Province of  
2           Davao Oriental is hereby renamed as Barangay Ernesto D. Violan.

3           **SEC. 2.** The renaming of Barangay San Isidro as Barangay Ernesto D. Violan  
4           shall be effective upon ratification of the majority of the votes cast by qualified  
5           voters in a plebiscite to be conducted and supervised by the Commission on  
6           Elections (COMELEC) in the present Barangay San Isidro, Municipality of Lupon,  
7           Province of Davao Oriental in compliance with Section 13 (g) of Republic Act No.  
8           7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

9           The expenses for such plebiscite shall be borne by the Municipality of Lupon,  
10          Province of Davao Oriental.

11          **SEC. 3.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the  
12          Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
