AN ACT
INTEGRATING THE CONSOLACION COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF CONSOLACION, PROVINCE OF CEBU, INTO THE CEBU
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY (CTU), TO BE KNOWN AS THE CTU-
CONSOLACION CAMPUS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "Cebu Technological University-
2 Consolacion Campus Act".
3

4 SEC. 2. The Consolacion Community College in the Municipality of Consolacion,
5 Province of Cebu, is hereby integrated into the Cebu Technological University (CTU) as a
6 regular campus, to be known as the CTU-Consolacion Campus. It shall be under the direct
7 supervision of the CTU.
8

9 SEC. 3. The Board of Regents of the CTU, hereinafter referred to as the Board, shall be
10 authorized to determine the structure, composition, and size of the faculty and staff of the
11 Consolacion Campus.
12

13 SEC. 4. The CTU President shall have overall supervision and management over the
14 Consolacion Campus, which shall be headed by a Campus Administrator who shall render
15 full-time service and be appointed or designated by the Board upon the recommendation of
16 the search committee and the President, subject to the guidelines, qualifications and
17 standards set by the Board.
18

19 SEC. 5. All assets, real and personal, personnel, and records of the Consolacion
20 Community College located in the Municipality of Consolacion, Province of Cebu, as well
21 as liabilities or obligations, shall be transferred to the CTU: *Provided*, That the positions,
22 rights, and security of tenure of faculty members and personnel therein employed under
23 existing laws prior to their integration into the CTU shall be respected.
24

25 All parcels of land belonging to the government occupied by the Consolacion
26 Community College shall be transferred to the CTU, and shall be titled under its name:

1 *Provided, That should the Consolacion Campus or the CTU cease to exist or be abolished or*
2 *should such aforementioned parcels of land be no longer needed by the CTU, the same shall*
3 *revert to the concerned LGU or to the Republic of the Philippines, as the case may be.*
4

5 **SEC. 7.** The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included
6 in the annual General Appropriations Act (GAA).
7

8 The Municipality of Consolacion shall provide the same assistance until such time that
9 the amount necessary for the continued operation and maintenance of the Campus shall be
10 included in the annual GAA.
11

12 **SEC. 6.** Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Board, shall issue
13 the implementing rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this Act.
14

15 **SEC. 8.** If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or
16 unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and
17 effect.
18

19 **SEC. 9.** All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations contrary
20 to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed or modified accordingly.
21

22 **SEC. 10.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
23 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
