## AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A PROVINCIAL OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE PROVINCE OF KALINGA, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Scnate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. There shall be established in the Province of Kalinga, an office of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) to be known as the CHED-Kalinga Provincial Office. It shall be headed by a provincial director.
- SEC. 2. The CHED shall determine the organizational structure and staffing pattern for the CHED-Kalinga Provincial Office and submit the same to the Department of Budget and Management for approval.
- SEC. 3. The Chairperson of the CHED shall immediately include in the CHED's program the operationalization of the CHED-Kalinga Provincial Office.
- SEC. 4. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the approval of this Act, the CHED shall issue the necessary rules and regulations for its effective implementation.
- SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
