AN ACT CONVERTING THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO) EXTENSION OFFICE LOCATED IN MANDALUYONG CITY INTO A REGULAR LTO DISTRICT OFFICE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The existing Land Transportation Office (LTO)
2 Extension Office located in Mandaluyong City is hereby converted
3 into a regular LTO District Office.

4 SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Transportation
5 shall immediately include in the Department's program the
6 operationalization of a regular LTO District Office in Mandaluyong
7 City, the initial funding of which shall be charged against the current
8 year's appropriation of the LTO Extension Office located in
9 Mandaluyong City. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for
10 the continued operation of the regular LTO District Office shall be
11 included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

1 SEC. 3. The Secretary of the Department of Transportation
2 shall issue such rules and regulations necessary for the effective
3 implementation of this Act.

4 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
5 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
6 circulation.
