# AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO LIANG XI WU

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- **SECTION 1.** Mr. Liang XI Wu is hereby granted Philippine citizenship with all the rights, privileges and prerogatives, as well as the duties and obligations appurtenant thereto under the Constitution and the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.
- **SEC. 2.** Mr. Wu shall take the Oath of Allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines before an officer duly authorized to administer the same. The Oath of Allegiance shall be registered with the Bureau of Immigration.
- **SEC. 3.** Upon registration of the Oath of Allegiance, the Bureau of Immigration shall issue a Certificate of Naturalization to Mr. Wu who shall thereupon enter into the full enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.
- **SEC. 4.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.

## AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO LIANG XI WU

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This measure seeks to grant Philippine citizenship to Mr. Liang Xi Wu, giving him all the rights, privileges and prerogatives, as well as the duties and obligations appurtenant there to under the Constitution and the laws of the land.

Mr. Liang Xi Wu has been a permanent resident of the country for the past fifteen years. During this time, he has been engaged in different business endeavors such as construction and manufacturing of various goods – greatly contributing to the economy of the country. He also employs hundreds of Filipinos in his businesses and is planning to employ more in the future.

He gives back to the Filipino people and to the country by regularly donating part of his income to civic activities of the Filipino Chinese Chamber of Commerce, a business organization in which he is a member of. Aside from this, he has also rendered active support and participation to the activities of the Philippine-Chinese Charitable Association under Dr. James Dy, and has donated various medical equipment and sponsored medical assistance to the patients of the Chinese General Hospital. Indeed, Mr. Liang Xi Wu has a big heart for to the Filipino people, and he has shown this again when he helped those who have been affected by the eruption of Taal in January 2020, by donating thousands of rubber slippers to evacuees.

It has been a dream of Mr. Liang Xi Wu to finally become a Filipino citizen, and in the years that he has been living as a permanent resident of the Philippines, he has proven that he is able to make valuable contributions to our country, and that he has nothing but the best intentions in seeking for citizenship. Mr. Liang Xi Wu merits consideration to have the privilege of becoming a naturalized Filipino as he has continually displayed his love for the Philippines and its people.


