AMENDING PARAGRAPH (A), SECTION 393, CHAPTER IV, TITLE I, BOOK III OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160, THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, AS AMENDED, INCREASING THE BENEFITS OF BARANGAY OFFICIALS

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Barangays, as local government units, are administrative agencies that serve as front liners in government service whose availability is on a 24/7 basis.

During the height of the pandemic in 2020 and 2021, barangay officials were tasked to implement the policies and directives of the national government for the delivery of the required services and assistance to the people from lockdown and quarantine operations, monitoring, testing to "ayuda" distribution, to name a few.

Barangays are the closest to the people to effect immediate and timely government service which make their officials function beyond the normal service hours and days of the government.

Thus, it is the objective of this bill to provide more benefits to barangay officials to recognize the performance of the duty imposed upon them not only by law but by the demands of their constituents and the nature of their office.

AMENDING PARAGRAPH (A), SECTION 393, CHAPTER IV, TITLE I, BOOK III OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160, THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, AS AMENDED, INCREASING THE BENEFITS OF BARANGAY OFFICIALS

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph (a), Section 393, Chapter IV, Title I, Book III of 2 Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 393, Benefits of Barangay Officials. -4 5 (a) Barangay officials, including barangay tanods and members of the lupong tagapamayapa, shall receive honoraria, allowances, and such 6 7 other emoluments as may be authorized by law or barangay, municipal or city ordinance in accordance with the provisions of this Code, but in 8 9 no case shall it be less than [One thousand pesos (P1,000.00)] TWENTY PERCENT (20%) ABOVE 10 THE MINIMUM WAGE RATE **PREVAILING IN THE REGION** per month for the punong barangay 11 12 and [Six hundred pesos (P600.00)] THE MINIMUM WAGE RATE **PREVAILING IN THE REGION** per month for the sangquniang 13 barangay members, barangay treasurer, and barangay secretary: 14 Provided, however, That the annual appropriations for personal services 15 shall be subject to the budgetary limitations prescribed under Title Five, 16 Book II of this Code; 17
- 18 XXX."

19 Sec. 2. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, proclamations and/or 20 administrative regulations which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are 21 hereby amended, modified, superseded or repealed accordingly. 1 Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days from its publication in the 2 Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
