RESOLUTION
CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING CARLOS EDRIEL POQUIZ YULO FOR WINNING THREE GOLD MEDALS IN THE FLOOR EXERCISE, VAULT AND PARALLEL BARS EVENTS AND A SILVER MEDAL IN THE ALL-AROUND EVENT IN THE MEN'S DIVISION OF THE 9TH SENIOR ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD LAST JUNE 17-18, 2022 IN DOHA, QATAR

WHEREAS, Art. XIV, Section 19 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that "the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;"

WHEREAS, it is in recognition of this policy that we recognize significant achievements in the field of sports to encourage and incentivize excellence among our athletes;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has, on numerous occasions, recognized and give commendation to outstanding Filipino athletes for bringing pride and honor to the country by winning in international sports events;

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2022, Carlos Edriel Yulo made history as he became the first Filipino to win a medal in the Asian Championships' history when he clinched the silver medal in the men's all-around event;

WHEREAS, Yulo made history once more as he won the Philippines' first gold medal in the Asian Gymnastics Championships after ruling the men's floor exercise event;

WHEREAS, the current world champion, Yulo, topped the men's vault event recording 14.8 points besting out athletes from Japan and Korea;


WHEREAS, the Filipino gymnast reigned yet again after tallying an impressive score of 15.167 points in the men's parallel bars event outdoing athletes from Japan and China;

WHEREAS, Yulo prevail in the continental meet with the most number of golds in the men's division as he bagged a total of four medals out of the seven individual events in the Senior Artistic Gymnastics Asian Championships;

WHEREAS, Carlos Edriel Yulo deserves the highest praise and commendation for bringing honor and recognition to the country and for serving as an inspiration to future generations of Filipino athletes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, for the Senate of the Philippines to express its congratulations and commendations to Carlos Edriel Poquiz Yulo for winning three gold medals in floor exercise, vault and parallel bars events and a silver medal in the all-around event in the Men's Division of the 9th Senior Artistic Gymnastics Asian Championships held last June 17-18, 2022 in Doha, Qatar.
