AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10912, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 2016"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Republic Act No. 10912, otherwise known as "Continuing Professional Development Act of 2016" or CPD Law was enacted by Congress and lapsed into law on July 21, 2016 with the primary intent to promote and upgrade the practice of professions in the country by continuously improving the competencies of the Filipino professionals in accordance with and comparable to the international standards of practice. Thereby, this ensures their contribution in uplifting the general welfare, economic growth and development of the nation.

However, the implementation of CPD Law has been met with much resistance from professionals, most especially teachers, engineers, accountants, physicians and nurses, among others, particularly the required forty-five (45) CPD units in the renewal of professional identification cards (PICs). Thus, there were several bills filed in the previous Congress that seek to repeal or amend the CPD Law. The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC), in response to this clamor and various hearings of the Senate Committee on Civil Service and Government Reorganization and the House Committee on Higher Education issued Resolution No. 2019-1146, amending relevant provisions of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the CPD Law, repealing the imposition of 45 CPD units in the renewal of PICs. The

PRC Resolution provided a transition period for the implementation of Section 10 of CPD Law, until such time the antecedent requirements as indicated by PRC in their said Resolution shall have been accomplished, such as the formulation of Career Progression and Specialization for every profession, pursuant to Section 12 of the CPD Law.

Career progression and specialization is a vital and important tool and requirement in addressing professionals' welfare, employment and compensation issues, job mismatch, portability and comparability of qualifications, and to facilitate mobility in the local, regional and international labor markets. With Career Progression and Specialization, quality assured CPD credit units can be transferred or awarded to higher level of qualifications pursuant to the Philippine Qualification Framework (PQF).

Towards career progression and specialization, there must be in place a Qualification Portfolio Assessment Standards for every profession to ensure quality assurance in the recognition and award of higher level of qualifications for every professional. Moreover, the Index of Occupational Standards (IOS) of the Department of Budget and Management and the Qualification Standards of Positions of the Civil Service Commission, including those in the private sector through the Department of Labor and Employment need to be reviewed, revised and restructured/updated in accordance with the standards of practice and qualifications indicated in the Career Progression and Specialization of each profession.

In view of the above premises and concerns, there is a need to amend certain provisions of RA No. 10912 or the CPD law. Hence, the approval of this bill is earnestly requested.

Sec. 3. Section 10 of Republic Act No. 10912 is hereby amended to read as follows:

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"Sec. 10. CPD as Mandatory Requirement in the [Renewal of Professional License and Accreditation System | UPGRADING OF **OUALIFICATIONS** for the Practice of Professions. — The CPD is hereby made as a mandatory requirement in the [renewal of the PICs of UPGRADING OF QUALIFICATIONS TOWARDS CAREER PROGRESSION AND SPECIALIZATION OF all registered and licensed professionals under the regulation of the PRC. WHENEVER THERE IS AN UPGRADE OR MOVEMENT OF POF QUALIFICATION LEVEL OF A PROFESSIONAL AS A RESULT OF THE TRANSFER OR AWARD OF CPD CREDIT UNITS FOR CAREER PROGRESSION AND SPECIALIZATION, THIS SHALL BE INDICATED AS **ADDITIONAL** INFORMATION IN THE PIC DURING THE RENEWAL CORRESPONDINGLY, A CERTIFICATE PERIOD. REGISTRATION SHALL BE ISSUED BY THE PROFESSIONAL REGULATORY **BOARDS** AND THE **PROFESSIONAL** REGULATION COMMISSION TO **APPROPRIATE OUALIFICATION TITLE OBTAINED BASED ON POF** QUALIFICATION LEVEL. THE PRC SHALL LIKEWISE **MAINTAIN A REGISTRY OF THESE QUALIFICATION TITLES** FOR **EVERY** PROFESSION: PROVIDED. **THAT** PROFESSIONALS WHO ARE COVERED BY MUTUAL RECOGNITION AGREEMENTS (MRAs), WHO DESIRES THAT THEIR QUALIFICATIONS BE RECOGNIZED/REGISTERED UNDER THESE AGREEMENTS SHALL COMPLY WITH THE MANDATORY CPD REQUIRED.

Sec. 4. After Section 10 of R.A. No. 10912, a new Section is hereby added which shall read as follows:

"SEC. 11. EXEMPTION FROM MANDATORY CPD FOR OFWS. — OVERSEAS FILIPINO WORKERS (OFWS) WHILE

WORKING OR PRACTICING THEIR **PROFESSIONS** OVERSEAS ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE MANDATORY REQUIREMENT FOR CPD. HOWEVER, PROFESSIONALS COVERED BY MUTUAL RECOGNITION AGREEMENTS (MRAS), WHO MAY WISH THAT THEIR QUALIFICATIONS PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE BE RECOGNIZED REGISTERED BASED ON THESE AGREEMENTS SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CPD: PROVIDED, THAT OFWS/PROFESSIONALS WHO PRACTICE THEIR PROFESSIONS OVERSEAS SHALL SUBMIT TO PRC AND RESPECTIVE CPD COUNCILS, THEIR EDUCATION. TRAINING AND WORK EXPERIENCE OBTAINED OR ACOUIRED OVERSEAS FOR PURPOSES OF EARNING APPROPRIATE CPD UNITS."

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Sec. 5. Section 11 of Republic Act No. 10912 is hereby renumbered as Section 12.

Sec. 6. Section 12 of Republic Act No. 10912 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. [12] 13. Career Progression and Specialization. – The PRC and the PRBs, in consultation with the AIPO/APO, the Civil Service Commission (CSC), other concerned government agencies and industry stakeholders, shall formulate and implement a Career Progression and Specialization Program for every profession. The Career Progression and Specialization Program shall form part of the CPD.

CAREER "THE RESPECTIVE **PRBs** AND THEIR PROGRESSION AND SPECIALIZATION COUNCILS AFTER DUE CONSULTATION WITH THEIR AIPO/APO AND SHALL CONCERNED STAKEHOLDERS, DEVELOP, PROMULGATE AND **IMPLEMENT QUALIFICATION** Α STANDARDS FOR **EVERY** ASSESSMENT **QUALIFICATION OR STANDARDS OF PRACTICE INDICATED** IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CAREER PROGRESSION AND SPECIALIZATION. TO ENSURE QUALITY ASSURANCE IN THE AWARD OF QUALIFICATIONS, THE PRBs AND PRC SHALL ACCREDIT QUALIFICATION PORTFOLIO ASSESSMENT CENTERS.

"THE CAREER PROGRESSION AND SPECIALIZATION SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED AND ENFORCED IN THE QUALIFICATION STANDARDS OF ALL POSITIONS IN GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE ENTITIES COVERED BY THE PRACTICE OF PROFESSION. ALONG THIS, THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION SHALL REVIEW, UPDATE AND REVISE THE QUALIFICATION STANDARDS OF POSITIONS IN GOVERNMENT.

"IN THE CASE OF POSITIONS IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR, THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT SHALL COORDINATE AND UNDERTAKE THE REVIEW, UPDATING AND REVISION WITH CONCERNED PRIVATE ENTITIES THROUGH THEIR HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT OFFICERS AND MONITOR THEIR COMPLIANCE.

"ALL QUALIFICATION TITLES REGISTERED FOR EVERY PROFESSION UNDER THEIR RESPECTIVE CAREER PROGRESSION AND SPECIALIZATION PROGRAM SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE PHILIPPINE **STANDARD** OCCUPATIONAL CLASSIFICATION (PSOC) AND THE INDEX OF OCCUPATIONAL SERVICES, POSITION TITLES AND **SALARY GRADES (IOS) OF THE POSITION CLASSIFICATION** AND COMPENSATION SYSTEM OF THE GOVERNMENT. AS SUCH THE PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT COORDINATION WITH PRBs AND PRC SHALL REVIEW, **UPDATE AND REVISE THE PSOC AND IOS."**

Sec. 7. Section 13 of Republic Act No. 10912 is hereby renumbered as Section 14.

Sec. 8. Section 14 of Republic Act No. 10912 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. [14] **15**. *Funding*. – x x x.

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"The funding requirement herein mentioned shall be used for the regular operations of the CPD Councils, including the monitoring of the conduct of the CPD Programs **AND THE OPERATION OF PRBs**.

"The PRC shall review and approve the proposed budget for each CPD Council **AND PRBs**, taking into consideration the reasonable expenses that will be incurred for travel, honorarium/allowances, and *per diems*, when attending official CPD Council meetings or performing other related functions assigned to them.

"FUNDING FOR FULL COMPUTERIZATION OF THE CPD SYSTEM AND DATABASE DEVELOPMENT, ENHANCEMENT OF THE PROFESSIONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD TO DATA, AND HONORARIA CHAIRPERSON AND MEMBERS OF THE CPD COUNCIL OR THEIR ALTERNATES AS THE CASE MAY BE, MONITORING EXPENSES FOR THE CONDUCT OF CPD PROGRAM AND OTHER EXPENSES OF THE CPD COUNCILS, FORMULATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF CAREER PROGRESSION AND SPECIALIZATION PROGRAM AND THE CREATION OF PLANTILLA POSITIONS FOR THE TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT FOR **PRBs** SHALL PROVIDED FOR IN THE ANNUAL PRC BUDGET."

Sec. 9. The succeeding sections of Republic Act No. 10912 is hereby renumbered accordingly.

Sec. 10. *Implementing Rules and Regulations*. – The PRC and the PRBs, in consultation with the AIPO/APO and other stakeholders, shall promulgate the

- implementing rules and regulations (IRR) within six (6) months from the effectivity of
- 2 this Act.
- Sec. 11. Separability Clause. If any part or provision of this Act is declared
- 4 invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in
- 5 full force and effect.
- 6 Sec. 12. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, executive orders and other
- 7 administrative issuances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions
- 8 of this Act, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- 9 Sec. 10. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its
- 10 complete publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) newspapers of general
- 11 circulation in the Philippines.
