EXPLANATORY NOTE

Alternative dispute resolution or ADR has become an effective legal mechanism in settling controversies or disputes in court.

As a way of encouraging ADR and promoting its use, this bill seeks to provide the benefit, favorable to the accused, of lowering the penalty in case of conviction in criminal cases where the civil aspect of which is settled with finality through or by ADR.

It is submitted that with this proposal, criminal cases will be resolved with dispatch especially in determining and satisfying civil liability at the least which is impliedly instituted in the filing of such cases in court.

An immediate deliberation of this bill is thus requested.

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. A new section is hereby added under Chapter 1 of Republic Act
No. 9285 to be numbered and read as follows:

"SEC. 7. EFFECTS OF ADR ON CRIMINAL CASES. -4 SUBJECT TO THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING SECTION OF 5 THIS ACT, IN CRIMINAL CASES WHERE THE CIVIL ASPECT OF 6 7 WHICH IS SETTLED WITH FINALITY BY ADR THE PENALTY TO **BE IMPOSED SHALL BE AT LEAST TWO (2) DEGREES LOWER** 8 THAN THAT PRESCRIBED BY LAW. IF THE SUBJECT OFFENSE 9 CANNOT BE LOWERED BY TWO (2) DEGREES PURSUANT TO 10 ARTICLE 61 OF THE REVISED PENAL CODE (RPC) THEN THE 11 PENALTY TO BE IMPOSED SHALL BE FROM THE MINIMUM TO 12 THE NEXT LOWER PENALTY PRESCRIBED BY LAW." 13

15 SEC. 2. The Sections of Republic Act No. 9285 subsequent to Section 1 16 of this Act are hereby renumbered as Sections 8 to 57 accordingly.

18 SEC. 3. All laws, decrees, executive orders and rules and regulations 19 inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed and modified 20 accordingly.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect 15 days following its complete publication in the Official Gazette or at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation, whichever comes first.
