# AN ACT DECLARING THE MONTH OF JUNE OF EVERY YEAR AS THE "NATIONAL FRONTLINERS MONTH" IN THE ENTIRE COUNTRY AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

As we still face the continuing challenges brought by the Covid-19 pandemic, the significant contributions and important role of frontline workers to overcoming the dangers of a disease outbreak have been highlighted and magnified a hundredfold.

We have seen the courage, strength and commendable efforts of our frontline workers, especially our local government units (LGU) and barangay officials and employees, in relentlessly fighting the challenges of protecting and serving our communities. Most Filipinos were kept out of harm's ways - safe at home and were able to continue working and being with loved ones - because our frontline workers - the healthcare workers, food delivery drivers, supermarket workers, restaurant cooks, security guards, agriculture and fisheries workers, garbage collectors, bank employees, logistics workers, energy, water and other utility employees, police and military personnel, social workers, media people, and LGU and barangay workers — to name a few, have been working selflessly during this pandemic, reporting to their

# AN ACT DECLARING THE MONTH OF JUNE OF EVERY YEAR AS THE "NATIONAL FRONTLINERS MONTH" IN THE ENTIRE COUNTRY, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This Act shall be known as the "The National 1 Frontliners Month Act ". 2 3 SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy. - In recognition of Filipino heroism through 4 5 the hard work and sacrifices of our frontline workers, the month of June of every year is hereby declared as the "National Frontliners Month." 6 7 SEC. 3. Objectives of the Policy. - The National Frontliners Month aims 8 9 to: 10 a. Recognize the significant contributions of frontline workers, such as the healthcare workers, pharmacists, energy, water and other utility 11 sector employees, logistic workers, storekeepers, grocery and delivery 12 workers, bank employees, security guards, garbage collectors, media 13 people, social workers, police and military personnel, local government 14 unit employees, barangay officials, government workers, and other 15

- frontline workers, in providing basic services for the essential needs of the public, especially during a pandemic and other crises;
  - b. Highlight the heroism of our frontline workers in protecting public welfare and keeping the country going during times of calamities, disasters and other crises;
    - c. Give distinction to major and commendable efforts, response and measures undertaken by our frontline workers, particularly our local government unit and barangay officials and employees; and
    - d. Institutionalize the annual celebration that gives honor to our frontline workers for their essential role and heroic response to the needs of the Filipino people.

SEC. 4. Lead Agencies. - The Department of Health (DOH), the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), in coordination with the Civil Service Commission (CSC) and other government agencies, are mandated to conduct activities and programs that promote the principles and values espoused by our frontline workers as well as those that underscore, honor and/or reward our frontline workers on their essential role in nation building, and for their significant contribution in protecting public welfare.

SEC. 5. *Appropriations*. - The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included in the General Appropriations Act of the year following its enactment into law, and every year thereafter, as may be necessary.

SEC. 6. *Implementing Rules and Regulations*. - Within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this Act, the DOH, DOLE, DILG, and the CSC shall promulgate the necessary implementing rules and regulations (IRR) to implement the provisions of this Act. Such IRR shall take effect immediately thereafter.

SEC. 7. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 8. *Repealing Clause.* - All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, presidential proclamations, rules and regulations or parts thereof contrary to or inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 9. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines.
