A RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY IN AID OF LEGISLATION ON THE PROLIFERATION OF SPAM AND PHISHING TEXT MESSAGES IN THE COUNTRY WITH THE END IN VIEW OF PROTECTING THE CONSUMERS' RIGHTS TO PRIVACY AND SECURITY

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to: i) "protect the fundamental human rights of privacy, of communication while ensuring free flow of information to promote innovation and growth"; and ii) "ensure that personal information in information and communications system in the government and in the private sector are secured and protected";²

WHEREAS, spam messages refer to "unsolicited usually commercial messages (such as emails, text messages, or Internet posting) sent to a large number of recipient or posted in a large number of places.³" Phishing refers to the "fraudulent attempt to obtain a user's sensitive information such as usernames, passwords and credit card details by disguising oneself as a trustworthy entity in an electronic communication.⁴" Text message phishing also called as smishing is a phishing which uses text message to carry out the fraudulent activity;⁵

WHEREAS, last year, there were various complaints from consumers on spam messages and phishing messages they received from various sources. In fact, in November 2021, Globe Telecom Inc., one of the leading telecommunications company in the country, reported that it has deactivated 5,670 mobile phone numbers and blocked 71 million spam messages in 2021 alone amidst numerous complaints it received from the public of the dodgy job offers they receive on their mobile phones.⁶

WHEREAS, on November 23, 2021, the National Privacy Commission (NPC) revealed that based on their initial investigation, the recent smishing activities in the country are run by a global crime syndicate;⁷

WHEREAS, on November 26, 2021, recognizing the urgency of the matter, ten government agencies have joined efforts through the creation of an interagency group to address the recent surge of spam and phishing text messages in the country.⁸ The group spearheaded by the Cybercrime Investigation and Coordinating Center (CICC) is composed of CICC, NPC, Department of Information and Communications Technology, National Telecommunications Commission, Department of Justice, Department of Trade and Industry, Department of Labor and Employment, Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas, National Security Council and Anti-Money Laundering Council.⁹

WHEREAS, on November 28, 2021, the NPC has formally launched an investigation to determine whether telecommunication companies exercised diligence in transacting with data aggregators linked to the sending of text messages offering spurious jobs and investment schemes;¹⁰

WHEREAS, despite the creation of the inter-agency group and the NPC's initiatives to investigate the proliferation of spam and text messages in the country, latest data reveals that this is still an on-going concern in the country. In June 2022,

the Philippine Long Distance Corporation Inc. (PLDT), another leading telecommunications company in the country reported that in just three days, i.e. June 11-14, 2022, PLDT blocked more than 23 million text messages that try to get consumer's personal data. According to PLDT, these malicious messages contains phishing website that posed as legitimate organizations such as banks, tour operators and recruitment agencies. Moreover, from January to June 15, 2022, Globe has already blocked over 138 million spam and scam text messages; 13

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the government to ensure that the consumers' right to privacy are protected and that they are not victimized by fraudulent activities facilitated through spam and phishing messages. Hence, it is important that the government through relevant government agencies come up with an effective intervention to stop the proliferation of these unsolicited text messages in the country;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to direct the appropriate Senate Committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the proliferation of spam and phishing text messages in the country with the end in view of protecting the consumers' right to privacy and security.
