



**RESOLUTION**  
**COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING CARL JAMMES MARTIN FOR**  
**SUCCESSFULLY DEFENDING HIS WORLD BOXING ASSOCIATION**  
**(WBA) ASIA SUPER BANTAMWEIGHT TITLE**

1           WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 of the Philippine Constitution  
2 mandates that "the State shall promote physical education and encourage  
3 sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training  
4 for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork and  
5 excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry";

6           WHEREAS, Carl Jammes Martin, is a professional Filipino boxer with an  
7 unblemished boxing record of twenty wins, zero defeats, with sixteen  
8 knockouts.

9           WHEREAS, Carl Jammes Martin, successfully defended his first World  
10 Boxing Association (WBA) Asia Super Bantamweight title against Charles Tondo  
11 in Manila City, Philippines;

12           WHEREAS, Ifugao's boxing prodigy, has defeated his Tanzanian  
13 opponent with an impressive one-sided victory via unanimous decision win;

14           WHEREAS, the judges scored the bout in favor of Carl Jammes Martin,  
15 with official scorecards of 118-110, 119-109, and 119-109;

1           WHEREAS, his remarkable performance serves as an inspiration to all  
2 Filipino athletes to excel in their respective fields of sport: Now, therefore, be  
3 it

4           RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, as it hereby resolved, Commending and  
5 congratulating Carl Jammes Martin for successfully defending his World Boxing  
6 Association (WBA) Asia Super Bantamweight title.
